## Welcome to the Borough of Oaklyn "CATCH THAT HOMETOWN SPIRIT"

- -All Borough Ordinances are on our website www.oaklyn-nj.net along with the Borough's Community Calendar.
- -Trash Schedule: Recycling Entire town is TUESDAY

Trash Districts 1 & 2 is WEDNESDAY Trash Districts 3 & 4 is THURSDAY

\*\*Large "Bulk" items go out on regular trash day

- -A district map is included
- -Voting- Districts 1 & 2 is at the Fire Hall (21 W. Clinton Ave) and Districts 3 & 4 is at the VFW (5 Manor Ave)
- -Below are a few most common ordinances:
  - BO 120-4 Parking Prohibited on any of the streets between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
  - BO 69-1A and 55-5 All Dogs and cats must be registered in the Borough of Oaklyn. (see enclosed notice)
  - BO 119-13.1 All trash receptacles shall be placed at the curb line no earlier than 3:00 p.m. on the day before the designated day of collection and shall be removed by 11:59 p.m. on the date of designated collection.
  - BO 111-23 It shall be a violation of this article to sweep, rake, blow or otherwise place yard waste that is not containerized at the curb or along the street. (see enclosed)
  - BO 124--1 A permit must be obtained from the Borough to conduct a yard sale.
  - BO 98-3 Door to Door Solicitation is prohibited in the Borough without a permit. A list of current solicitors permits is available on the Borough website. Always ask to see any solicitors permit. It will have the Borough of Oaklyn's seal on it if it was issued by the Borough.

### **Overnight Parking**

No person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am on any street in the Borough of Oaklyn.

Residents can apply for an overnight parking permit through the Oaklyn Police Department. Permits can be found on our website, Oaklyn-NJ.net, under the permits and forms link at the top of the page or by stopping in the police station. Upon inspection of the property and the vehicles, the Chief of Police will render a decision on said application. Parking permits cost \$50 per year and must be renewed each year.

Vehicles that need to park in the street for one night can be called in to the Police Department. The telephone number to call in a vehicle is 856-854-8200. Failure to call in a vehicle overnight could result in a parking ticket.

### **ANIMAL LICENSING**

Owners of dogs/cats 7 months of age or older are required by the State of New Jersey statute to license their animals in the municipality where they are housed. (NJSA 4:19-15.2)

Animal Licensing revenue is required to be placed in a special municipal account separate from any other accounts and shall be used for the following purposes only: capturing and impounding stray dogs and cats, prevention and control of rabies and pay all state animal registration fees.

To register dogs/cats in the Borough of Oaklyn proof of rabies vaccine, good thru November 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year, should be supplied to the Borough along with the required licensing fee. (NJSA 4:19-15.2a)


### **Annual Dog & Cat License Fees**

Male/Female, spayed or neutered	\$20.00
Male/Female, unsprayed or unneutered	\$25.00
Late Fees:	
License purchased after March 31	\$15.00
License purchased after June 30	\$20.00
License purchased after September 30	\$25.00

### Ways You Can Help Keep Oaklyn & It's Waterways Clean!

- Clean up your grass clippings when cutting your grass. Ordinance # 111-3
- Don't rake leaves out until your scheduled pick-up.
   Ordinance # 111-23
  - Clean up after your pets. Ordinance # 111-16
  - Trash should not be put out at the curb before 6:00pm, the evening prior to your pick-up day.

    Ordinance # 119-3
- Do not mix trash & recycling. Ordinance # 119-8
- Trash should be in a covered can and bags tied.
   Ordinance # 119-1
- Make sure to properly dispose of leftover household chemicals, paints and automotive fluids. These leftover chemicals should never be thrown away. Take them to a household hazardous waste collection center where they can be recycled.
