

Subject: Criminal Complaint Against U.S. FBI, and Florida DOH and Dr. Robert Dahlin for Torture, Cybercrimes, False Imprisonment, and Conspiracy

Dear Sir or Madam,

I, Heidi Marjaana Lahteenmaa, D.O., a dual Finnish-American citizen and licensed physician (Florida License No. OS16911), file this urgent criminal complaint against the U.S. Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), the Florida Department of Health (DOH), Dr. Robert Dahlin and affiliated actors for crimes from January 2023 to the present, with ongoing impact in Portugal. As a whistleblower who uncovered fraud at Teladoc, a \$2.6 billion global telehealth corporation, and inadvertently exposed a likely sealed FBI investigation involving mafia and cyber gang operations, I have endured 2.5 years of lifethreatening persecution, documented in approximately 100,000 photos, four hard drives, 15 cellphones, 10 diaries, USB drives and more. On July 29, 2025, Polícia Judiciária/Interpol in Lisbon confirmed my concerns and recommended filing with DIAP.

From January 2023 to January 2025 in Palm Beach, Florida, I suffered environmental and psychological torture: sewage drained into my apartment for six months, air conditioning was cut in blistering summer heat, and loud drilling occurred on my roof throughout the day. Nearly all communication and transportation (e.g., Uber) were severed, and I was incited to kill myself through hacked apps, urging me to jump off the balcony and telling me I would die. I was coerced to cover all windows for over a month and perform exhaustive tasks (e.g., clicking a Teladoc clock every five minutes for 12 hours) while falsely imprisoned and prevented from escaping. These acts, combined with chronic anemia (Hg 9.1 g/dL) and a canceled breast biopsy due to hackers terminating my health insurance, left me dangerously weak.

Instead of assisting, the FBI/NSA facilitated an involuntary five-day psychiatric detention (August 2024, Delray Medical Center) under Florida's Baker Act (Fla. Stat. § 394.451) without legal justification, using an illegal BA-52 form, no BA-32, forced antipsychotics, and an unauthorized proxy (Angel ~\$50,000 bill was issued, yet the discharge shows unknown payment, despite mentioning no insurance, suggesting a cover-up. Post-hospitalization, hackers canceled all my medical appointments, denying critical care. The

FBI either allowed my near-lethal torture by cybergangs right in front of them without intervening or, worse, did it themselves.

I eventually fled Florida in January 2025 and landed in Lisbon in April 2025, and with assistance from Polícia Judiciária and Interpol, I finally received medical care. The FBI's "cybercage" (fake internet, device control, blocked communications/transportation) and harassment persist. The DOH's fabricated lawsuit (Case Nos. 2023-54547, 24-004162PL) seeks to revoke my license, with a public hearing on August 5-6, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Eastern Time (https://zoom.us/join, Meeting ID: 691 353 6672) involving Dr. Dahlin's perjured psychosis diagnosis (November 2023) and coercion of colleagues and family to frame me as psychotic, despite his knowledge of my hacking evidence. His father, a federal agent, implicates FBI orchestration. The DOH issued an illegal license (January 3, 2024) without attestations (Fla. Stat. § 459.008), duplicated it, falsified records (possible RansomHub cyberattack), labeled me "impaired" without evaluation (Fla. Stat. § 90.603), and issued a subpoena without a certified copy or affidavit. I face witness intimidation and denial of counsel, forcing me to defend pro se against Teladoc and mafia threats, violating my rights (Sixth Amendment, ECHR Article 47). These actions block my career, income, and medical care, endangering my life. I am still yet to have a breast biopsy, and this is due to the retaliatory actions by the FBI, their affiliated actors, and their inability to respond appropriately. Detailed allegations are listed in the "Allegations of Government Misconduct" attachment.

The U.S. government's orchestrated persecution, including torture and systematic career and life destruction, seemingly justified in their view under the pretext of a sealed investigation, constitutes war crime-level violations of international law, regardless of criminal elements (e.g., mafia, cybergangs, Teladoc). This unprecedented failure to conduct their healthcare investigation lawfully and humanely demands urgent action to halt this injustice, ensure my safety, and restore my ability to practice medicine. I request an investigation and termination of the U.S. government's cyber sabotage, which prevents me from accessing medical care with insurance and denies employment, amounting to a slow death sentence. I also request access to legal counsel to address the life destruction caused by Dr. Robert Dahlin, the Florida DOH, the FBI and their associates. It is appalling that I am not allowed to have a lawyer in this situation. I request a case number, to ensure a permanent record of this report, even if dismissed.

Severity of Retaliation and Refusal to Return to U.S.

As a Finnish citizen, I seek protection under Portuguese law (Penal Code Articles 134, 147, 152-A, 240; Law No. 109/2009), the Portuguese Constitution (Articles 9, 25, 26, 64), and EU frameworks (EU Charter Articles 4, 6, 8, 47; GDPR; Whistleblower Directive 2019/1937).

I refuse to return to the U.S. without guaranteed safety due to prior torture, false imprisonment, and threats. U.S. whistleblowers face grave risks even with U.S. government protection, which is grossly inadequate (e.g., John Barnett; Boeing). Further, the audacity of preventing me from practicing medicine, issuing an illegal license, and then

framing me using that license stems from the FBI's incompetent, reckless investigation and prioritization of a cover-up over justice.

<u>Legal Basis for Departamento de Investigação e Ação Penal (DIAP) Investigation:</u> The FBI's, and U. S. Government's actions in Portugal violate:

- Law No. 109/2009: Cybercrime (hacking, surveillance).
- Penal Code Article 147: False imprisonment (transportation/communication blocks).
- **Penal Code Article 152-A:** Torture (environmental, psychological).
- EU Charter Articles 4, 47: No torture, fair trial.
- GDPR: Unauthorized data access.
- EU Whistleblower Directive: Retaliation against whistleblowers.

I respectfully request:

- An investigation into these allegations, focusing on incidents in Portugal, with coordination from Polícia Judiciária and Interpol for cross-border cybercrime or organized crime threats.
- Documentation of any witness intimidation or denial of counsel as part of the investigation.
- Protective measures against ongoing harassment in Portugal, as permitted under Portuguese law.
- Issuance of a case number and receipt for this complaint.

I will provide more evidence from U.S. public hearing on August 5 and 6, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Eastern Time. (https://zoom.us/join, Meeting ID: 691 353 6672), to support these claims.

Conclusion

The FBI's 2.5-year campaign of orchestrated persecution, involving torture, false imprisonment, and cybercaging from Palm Beach to Lisbon, constitutes war crime-level retaliation for my Teladoc whistleblowing. Their fabricated lawsuit and denial of counsel continue to destroy my life in Portugal, blocking my medical practice and endangering my health. Alternatively, if not directly perpetrated by the FBI, the U.S. government and Biden-era FBI were so inept and corrupt that they failed to respond, allowing cybergang and mafia torture to unfold unchecked, continuing to the present. I trust the Departamento de Investigação e Ação Penal (DIAP) to investigate this grave injustice. I reserve my right to pursue further legal action against the U.S. government and other entities for these violations. Thank you for your urgent attention to this matter.
