

## **HACKING EVIDENCE; PART 1**


All the evidence in over 4 laptops, 15 phones, ~ 100 000 photos, 5 harddrives and more have been ignored.








Apparently my account at TGH was compromised. I did rotations there during residency









Not sure who the "Account Owner" suddenly was for my own account at FPL.

It's not my previous German landlord Remarks as we transferred the account to my name when I moved, and I was able to login just fine afterwards. Then the access got blocked.





