

Spiritual Communion**

3rd Decade

Queen of the Holy Rosary we recommend to you in this decade, all those who have been killed by the horrible practice of abortion.

Through your powerful intercession may God grant unto them the knowledge that their deaths were not in vain. Take them, Holy Mother, under the protection of your tender mantle until we are all one on the last day with the Father and your Son, the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Amen.

4th Decade

Queen of the Holy Rosary, we recommend to you in this decade, all those who have assisted with in any way the decision for a mother to have an abortion.

A Pilgrim's Prayer to St. Anne







The First Sorrowful Mystery THE AGONY IN THE GARDEN

Jesus comes with his disciples to Gethsemane: "Stay here, while I go yonder and pray." Entering the garden with Peter, James, and John, Jesus prays, "My soul is sorrowful unto death."

Jesus sees the sins of all mankind, whose guilt He has taken upon Himself. He sees the wrath of the Father which His sufferings must appease. So great is his anguish that His sweat becomes as drops of blood falling to the ground. An angel appears to Him from heaven to

strengthen Him. "Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet, not My will but Yours be done."

Finding the disciples asleep, "Could you not watch one hour with me?" Jesus is betrayed by Judas, cruelly bound and led away.

Father, by the merits of the agony of Jesus in the Garden, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

The Second Sorrowful Mystery THE SCOURGING AT THE PILLAR

Jesus is taken before the High Priest where He is falsely accused, buffeted and insulted.

The Jewish leaders take Jesus before Pilate, for only he can impose the death penalty. The robber, Barabbas, is preferred to Jesus. Pilate can "find no cause in Him," yet to appease the Jews, he orders Jesus to be scourged. The scourge is made of leather thongs to which are attached small sharp bones. Jesus is bound to a pillar and cruelly scourged until His whole body is covered with deep wounds.

The Lamb of God offers His suffering for the sins of mankind. Jesus suffers so much in His sacred flesh to satisfy, especially, for sins of the flesh. The prophesy of Isaiah is fulfilled: "He was wounded for our iniquities; He was bruised for our sins."

Father, by the merits of Jesus in this painful scourging, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

The Third Sorrowful Mystery THE CROWNING WITH THORNS

Pilate asks, "Are you a king?" Jesus answers: "I am a King, but My kingdom is not of this world."

In the praetorium, the soldiers place an old purple robe on Jesus in mockery of His claim to be a king. They fashion a crown out of thorns, and forcefully press it down upon His head. In His bound hands they place a reed, as a scepter, in mockery of His kingship. Kneeling before Him in derision,

they spit on Him, and cry out: "Hail, King of the Jews!" Taking the reed from His hand they strike Him on the head, driving the thorns more deeply into His scalp.

Pilate brings Jesus before the people, hoping His pitiful sight will soften them: "Behold the man!" Their response: "Crucify Him! Crucify Him!" Our Blessed Lord submitted to this terrible humiliation to make reparation for our pride.

Father, by the merits of this painful humiliation, have mercy on us and on the whole world

The Fourth Sorrowful Mystery THE CARRYING OF THE CROSS

One condemned to death by crucifixion is forced to carry the cross to the place of execution. The suffering of Jesus is intense as the cross is laid on His bruised and wounded back and shoulders. Weak and exhausted from loss of blood, lack of food and rest, Jesus falls three times under the cross.

Jesus meets His afflicted Mother causing untold anguish in the Hearts of Son and Mother.

The countenance of Jesus is disfigured with blood and sweat, with dust and spittle. Veronica wipes His face, leaving on her towel the image of His countenance.

Fearing that Jesus might die on the way, the soldiers force Simon of Cyrene to carry the cross behind Jesus. Jesus speaks to weeping women; "Weep not for Me, but for yourselves and your children." "If anyone is to be My disciple, let him take up his cross and follow Me."

Father, by the merits of this painful journey to Calvary, have mercy on us and on the whole world

The Fifth Sorrowful Mystery THE CRUCIFIXION

The hands and feet of Jesus are nailed to the cross in the presence of His afflicted Mother.

"Father, forgive them for they know not what they do."

"This day you will be with Me in paradise."

"Woman, behold your Son. Son, behold your Mother."


"My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"

And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, has also conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren; for nothing will be impossible for God."

Therefore, my sons, be zealous for the law and give your lives for the covenant of our fathers. Remember the deeds that our fathers did in their times, and you shall win great glory and an everlasting name. Was not Abraham found faithful in trial, and it was reputed to him as uprightness? Joseph, when in distress, kept the commandment, and he became master of Egypt. Phinehas our father, for his burning zeal, received the covenant of an everlasting priesthood.

Joshua, for executing his commission, became a judge in Israel. Caleb, for bearing witness before the assembly, received an inheritance in the land. David, for his piety,



received as a heritage a throne of everlasting royalty. Elijah, for his burning zeal for the law, was taken up to heaven. Hananiah, Azariah and Mishael, for their faith, were saved from the fire. Daniel, for his innocence, was delivered from the jaws of lions. And so, consider this from generation to generation, that none who hope in him shall fail in strength. Do not fear the words of a sinful man, for his glory ends in corruption and worms. Today he is exalted, and tomorrow he is not to be found, because he has returned to his dust, and his schemes have perished. Children! Be courageous and strong in keeping the law, for by it you shall be glorified."

Prayer for Hope:

Sweet Holy Mother of Virtues, pray for us as we suffer this life, that we may always look to the hope of Christ's Resurrection and the promises of God to sustain us. Keep us close to your Virtuous Heart during trials and temptations. Day Three – For Charity Isaiah 23: 1-18

Oracle on Tyre: Wail, O ships of Tarshish, for your port is destroyed; from the land of the Kittim the news reaches them. Silence! You who dwell on the coast, you merchants of Sidon, Whose messengers crossed the sea over the deep waters, the grain of Shihor, the harvest of the Nile was her revenue, and she the merchant among nations.

Shame, O Sidon, fortress on the sea, for the sea has spoken: "I have not been in labor, nor given birth, nor raised young men, nor reared virgins." When it is heard in Egypt they shall be in anguish at the news of Tyre. Pass over to Tarshish, wailing, you who dwell on the coast! Is this your wanton city, whose origin is from old, whose feet have taken



her to dwell in distant lands? Who has planned such a thing against Tyre, the bestower of crowns, whose merchants are princes, whose traders are the earth's honored men? The LORD of hosts has planned it, to disgrace all pride of majesty, to degrade all the earth's honored men. Cross to your own land, O ship of Tarshish; the harbor is no more. His hand he stretches out over the sea, he shakes kingdoms; The LORD has ordered the destruction of Canaan's strongholds. You shall exult no more, he says, you who are now oppressed, virgin daughter Sidon. Arise; pass over to the Kittim, even there you shall find no rest. (These people are from the land of the Chaldeans, not Assyria.) She whom the impious founded, setting up towers for her, has had her castles destroyed, and has been turned into a ruin. Lament, O ships of Tarshish, for your haven is destroyed. On that day, Tyre shall be forgotten for seventy years.

With the days of another king, at the end of seventy years, it shall be for Tyre as in the song about the harlot: Take a harp, go about the city, O forgotten harlot; Pluck the strings skillfully, sing many songs, that they may remember you. At the end of the seventy years the LORD shall visit Tyre. She shall return to her hire and deal with all the world's kingdoms on the face of the earth. But her merchandise and her hire shall be sacred to the LORD. It shall not be stored up or laid away, but from her merchandise those who dwell before the LORD shall eat their fill and clothe themselves in choice attire.

Prayer for Charity:

Sweet Holy Mother of Virtues, pray that in the sight of God, our sins will be forgiven. Pray that we may forgive others their transgressions as God so charitably and generously forgives us. Intercede for us that God's anger will not last long but that His mercy will come soon.

Even though it seems our transgressions are unforgivable, Christ comes to us and clothes us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and salvation. Praised be to the Holy Virtuous Heart of God for his charity toward our sinful hearts. Let us give this charity to our brothers and sisters too as a lasting sign of the unity and generosity of God that He would send his Only Son, Jesus Christ

Our Lord to redeem us and to reconcile the world unto God. Let our consecrated hearts be dedicated to the service only for the sake of building the kingdom, and may we never boast of ourselves but give all our works over for the greater good and glory of God. Amen!

Day Four - For Humility Hosea 4: 1-9

Hear the word of the LORD, O people of Israel, for the LORD has a grievance against the inhabitants of the land: There is no fidelity, no mercy and no knowledge of God in the land. False swearing, lying, murder, stealing and adultery! In their lawlessness, bloodshed follows bloodshed. Therefore the land mourns, and everything that dwells in it languishes: The beasts of the field, the birds of the air, and even the fish of the sea perish. But let no one protest, let no one complain; with you is my grievance, O priests! You shall stumble in the day, and the prophets shall stumble with you at night; I will destroy your mother. My people perish for want of knowledge! Since you have rejected knowledge, I will reject you from my priesthood. Since you have ignored the law of your God, I will also ignore your sons. One and all they



sin against me, exchanging their glory for shame. They feed on the sin of my people, and are greedy for their guilt. The priests shall fare no better than the people: I will punish them for their ways, and repay them for their deeds.

When my soul fainted within me, I remembered the LORD; My prayer reached you in your holy temple. Those who worship vain idols forsake their source of mercy. But I, with resounding praise, will sacrifice to you; What I have vowed I will pay: deliverance is from the LORD. Then the

LORD commanded the fish to spew Jonah upon the shore.

Day Six – For Perseverance Jude 1-25

Jude, a slave of Jesus Christ and brother of James, to those who are called, beloved in God the Father and kept safe for Jesus Christ: may mercy, peace, and love be yours in abundance. Beloved, although I was making every effort to write to you about our common salvation, I now feel a need to write to encourage you to contend for the faith that was once for all handed down to the holy ones. For there have been some intruders, who long ago were designated for this condemnation, godless persons, who pervert the grace of our God into licentiousness and who deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ. I wish to remind you, although you know all things, that the Lord who once saved a people from the land of Egypt later destroyed those who did not believe. The angels too, who did not keep to their own domain but deserted their proper dwelling, he has kept in eternal chains, in gloom, for the judgment of the great day. Likewise, Sodom, Gomorrah, and the surrounding towns, which, in the same manner as they, indulged in sexual promiscuity and practiced unnatural vice, serve as an example by undergoing a punishment of eternal fire. Similarly, these dreamers nevertheless also defile the flesh, scorn lordship, and revile glorious beings. Yet the archangel Michael, when he argued with the devil in a dispute over the body of Moses, did not venture to pronounce a reviling judgment upon him but said, "May the Lord rebuke you!"

But these people revile what they do not understand and are destroyed by what they know by nature like irrational animals. Woe to them! They followed the way of Cain, abandoned themselves to Balaam's error for the sake of gain, and perished in the rebellion of Korah. These are blemishes on your love feasts, as they carouse fearlessly and look after themselves. They are waterless clouds blown about by winds, fruitless trees in late autumn, twice dead and uprooted. They are like wild waves of the sea, foaming up their shameless deeds, wandering stars, for whom the gloom of darkness has been reserved forever.

Enoch, of the seventh generation from Adam, prophesied also about them when he said, "Behold, the Lord has come with his countless holy ones to execute judgment on all and to convict everyone for all the godless deeds that they committed and for all the harsh words

godless sinners have uttered against him." These people are complainers, disgruntled ones who live by their desires; their mouths utter bombast as they fawn over people to gain advantage.


But you, beloved, remember the words spoken beforehand by the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ, for they told you, "In the last times there will be scoffers who will live according to their own godless desires." These are the ones who cause divisions; they live on the natural plane, devoid of the Spirit.

But you, beloved, build yourselves up in your most holy faith; pray in the Holy Spirit. Keep yourselves in the love of God and wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ that leads to eternal life. On those who waver, have mercy; save others by snatching them out of the fire; on others have mercy with fear, abhorring even the outer garment stained by the flesh. To the one who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you unblemished and exultant, in the presence of his glory, to the only God, our savior, through Jesus, Christ

Prayer for Perseverance

Sweet Holy Mother of Virtues, you experience persecution in so many ways. You suffered when your innocent Son, Jesus was condemned to death. Your heart agonized when He was spat upon, insulted and tortured as He carried His Cross up Calvary. Your heart was pierced while you watched your Son die on the Cross. Help us dear mother, to persevere in silence not lashing out to defend ourselves because we know we have been disobedient and unfaithful children. Help us always to trust in the mercy of Jesus to forgive our sins.

Help us with your grace to persevere in our faith in spite of corruption, famine, poverty, oppression, and persecution that surrounds us. Remind us that you and your Son Jesus will not abandon us during our trials. Let us rely on the Holy Spirit for Our consolation and not look to others to redeem us but to depend only on our One True Redeemer, Our Lord Jesus, the Christ. Pray for us to stay faithful at



the hour of our death, so that we may eternally exalt in the glories of God in the heavenly eternal world to come. Amen!

Day Seven – For Obedience James 4:1-7

Where do the wars and where do the conflicts among you come from? Is it not from your passions that make war within your members? You covet but do not possess. You kill and envy but you cannot obtain; you fight and wage war. You do not possess because you do not ask. You ask but do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions. Adulterers! Do you not know that to be a lover of the world means enmity with God? Therefore, whoever wants to be a lover of the world makes himself an enemy of God. Or do you suppose that the scripture speaks without meaning when it says, "The spirit that he has made to dwell in us tends toward jealousy"? But he bestows a greater grace; therefore, it says: "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." So submit yourselves to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
