

Prepare Your Family for Bushfire

Plan for the Worst

If you live in a bush fire prone area you may not be able to if bush fires arrive quickly. It is essential that all the family know what to do. Visit your states fire service website and make a plan. Suitable clothing is essential when the fire arrives including dust masks and goggles.

Clear Access to Your Home

Your home cannot be defended without clear access. Visibility will be reduced so clear paths around the structures and Static Water Supplies (tanks, pools and taps) will make it safer for you and emergency service to defend your home during an ember attack.

Reduce Fuel

Cut back long grass, overhanging trees within 10M of your home and remove leaves from the ground, roof & gutters. Remove flammable items such as bamboo screens, wood piles and clear the areas under your deck and house. Ensure the relief valve on all gas bottles are facing away from flammable materials.

Fight the Flames

A pool or water tank is a valuable resource during a fire. Increase its value by purchasing a stand alone fire fighting pump, hose and sprinkler system. You will then have the resources to defend your home, the Emergency Services will be glad for the help.

Practice and Repeat

Preparation is great, but practice make perfect. Schedule working bees to keep your yard clear of fuel and have monthly drills using your fire protection equipment. This will ensure you are Bush Fire Ready.
