TUMC has offered seasonal garden beds to the community for many years. Vic and Karen Miglioretto have coordinated this project for years and will retire in November. Some of the gardeners have been participating for years and the beds provide food for their families. If you'd like to find out more information and possible serve as a coordinator for the season beginning in Spring 2026, please contact the church office. The forms and practices for the program are already in place. In order for the program to continue next year, we need a volunteer (or group) to oversee the beds, manage weeds and be a contact for the people that farm during the gardening season (spring to harvest). There are about 28 beds.

Dancing Our Prayers

Saturday, November 22 | 5:00pm at Tabor Heights UMC

What does a decolonizing Thanksgiving look like? How might we grow in relationship with the communities that stewarded the land in the Pacific Northwest?

Dancing Our Prayers and United Methodist Churches in Southeast Portland are hosting a drumming and dancing service **for the whole community**, led by native young people from the Yakama Nation. This grace-filled, guilt-free, and relationship-centered service is a chance to learn and hear the stories and wisdom our native siblings have. Dancing Our Prayers focuses on conciliation, justice, and healing between the Christian Communities and Native America.

This is a family-friendly event.

Accessibility notes: Dancing Our Prayers leads music using a drum that can be particularly loud for persons with audio processing needs. A limited number of noise canceling headphones will be available upon request. Tabor Heights UMC is located 2 blocks East of the 71 Bus stop at 60th And Stark.

Dancing Our Prayers is a team of Native American students from the Yakama Nation who travel locally, regionally, and nationally sharing spirituality and faith through cultural revitalization and retention. Students drum and dance in full regalia and share their story and wisdom with the community. Dancing Our Prayers is a part of Mending Wings, a native lead faith-based non-profit organization.

We hope churches and community members will come together

for this unique opportunity to learn about local Native American culture and justice issues.
