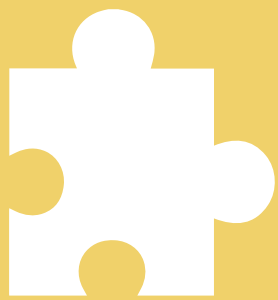




SALVATION
