This year, the solstice took place on Thursday, June 20, though the exact day alternates each year, taking place sometime between the 2oth-22nd. The sun was out yesterday for approximately 15 hours, 13 minutes, and 41 seconds! Shadows are also the shortest on this day. This particular summer solstice was our earliest in over 200 years. The leap year may also play in to this fact, as our calendar is never quite $100 \%$ in sync with the solar year. The exact day and time of the solstice is affected by the Earth's axis, the way it tilts, and where it lies in relation to

the sun on a given year. This accounts for the variations on when exactly the solstice takes place. The earth's tilt is 23.5 degrees off-vertical, meaning it does not spin in a perfect circle, and that each half of the globe tilts slightly closer or further away from the sun. Our days will now be getting a little bit shorter, up until the winter solstice on December 2I. Luckily, we have a lot more long days and summer weather to enjoy before then!
