ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SUMMIT HILLS ARCHITECTURAL PLANNING
& STREET MAINTENANCE ASSOCIATION

Ι

The name of this corporation is SUMMIT HILLS ARCHITECTURAL PLANNING & STREET MAINTENANCE ASSOCIATION.

II

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit mutual benefit corporation organized under the Nonprofit Mutual Benefit Corporation Law. The purpose of this corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under such law.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to provide for the management, maintenance, and preservation of the streets of the property described in the Declaration & Establishment of Protective Covenants & Restrictions, recorded by Frog Pond Associates, a California corporation doing business as "Summit Hills," on July 20, 1988 as Document No. 40952 in Volume 3171, Pages 626 to 679, inclusive, of Official Records of San Luis Obispo County, California, and to achieve and maintain through its architectural planning functions the aesthetic goals expressed in the Declaration, for the use and benefit of the lot

owners and members of the Association, and to generally administer the Declaration.

C. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private member or individual other than by acquiring, constructing, or providing management, maintenance and care of Association property and other than by a rebate of excess membership dues, fees, or assessments.

Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purposes and powers, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the specific purposes of this corporation.

These articles may be amended as provided in the bylaws of this corporation. If bylaws have not been adopted, these articles may be amended as provided in the Nonprofit Mutual Benefit Corporation Law.
