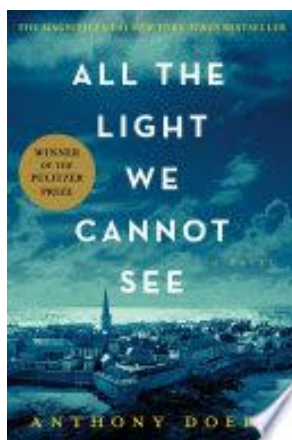

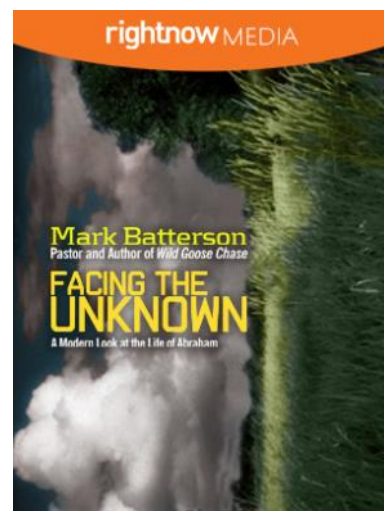
Bible Study

Building POP:	Johnathan McIlhinney James Blankenship (Rev. Sallye)	Purpose: To specifically manage the building itself, in particular maintenance needs of both repair and replacement.
Care POP:	Terry Samm-Garris Gloria Franklin (Revs. James & Sallye)	Purpose: To respond to the needs of congregants and their families, particularly in times of illnesses or grief.
Children's POP:	Tina Bailey Amanda Bartley (Rev. Sallye)	Purpose: To develop ministries to children both within and outside the walls of Warwick that are developmentally appropriate for their faith's formation.
Hospitality POP:	<i>Searching</i> (Rev. Sallye)	Purpose: To coordinate ideas and volunteers for 3rd Sunday Lunches and other special events.
LGBT POP:	Tristian Brown Lynsie McIlhinney (Revs. James & Sallye)	Purpose: To stay aware and facilitate ministry with the LGBT community. An emphasis on LGBT Youth has been determined.
Liturgy & the Arts POP:	Nate Masters Joe Emerson (Revs. Sallye & James)	Purpose: To create through the visual and performing arts experiences that inspire and nurture people's lives, primarily through worship.
Outreach POP:	<i>Searching</i> (Revs. Sallye & James)	Purpose: To engage our congregation in ministries beyond the church family, such as homelessness, disaster response and other needs beyond our local church.
Sewing POP:	Terry Samm-Garris Gloria Franklin (Rev. Sallye)	Purpose: To create through sewing items that create beauty and function for those who receive them.
Stewardship & Fund Raising POP:	Terry Samm-Garris (Rev. James)	Purpose: To develop or oversee specific fundraisers that shall be approved by council. The intent of fund raisers shall be specified for each event.
Strategic Planning POP:	Barbara Harvey Mark Snell-Cook (Revs. James & Sallye)	Purpose: To guide the congregation as we plan our future, establishing our mission and creating a long-range vision as possibilities emerge.
Sunday Mornings POP:	Barbara Harvey (Rev. Sallye)	Purpose: To staff the Sundays mornings of the church, specifically – readers, counters, ushers and preparers of communion.

The CROP Hunger Walk Needs YOU

Why Walk?

CROP Hunger Walks are interfaith events that build community while raising funds to end hunger in your own community AND also around the world. Everyone is welcome to join!

Your participation impacts individuals and families in more than 35 countries. In many developing nations, people can walk up to six miles a day to get food and water. One in nine people worldwide lack access to clean water and a healthy diet. We walk to be in solidarity, bring awareness to these issues and raise the funds for permanent change.

What is the impact?

Annually, CROP Hunger Walkers raise nearly \$10 million to bring help and hope.

How will you make a difference?

Funds you raise in a CROP Hunger Walk help global communities flourish.

\$25 supplies seeds and tools for a community garden to improve nutrition

\$100 provides 200 chicks for families, as a self-propagating food source

\$300 drills 10 meters of a shallow borehole well to improve hygiene and sanitation

\$1,000 builds a water pump for clean drinking water and community training for long-term success
