

# Kings of Spring no Boundaries Rules

1. \$250 entry fee. 10% goes to Mid City Nutrition Program. Sign up and Captain's meeting is at the Port Huron Yacht Club. Sign up will start at 5:00PM on 4/17/2020 with the Captain's meeting to follow.
2. All members on a boat must follow the Rules and Regulations for the body of water they are fishing in.
3. Tournament hours are intended to be 6:00 AM – 2:00 PM each day but may be adjusted by the tournament committee if needed. Monitor channel 68 for any changes.
4. Tournament officials will start boat check at appx. 5:15AM. This will take place on both sides of the Black River east of the Military Street Bridge. Have your Boat number ready for the officials to sign off.
5. This will be a shot gun start in American waters. The north line will be at the brick building at Lakeside beach. The south line will be at the dock for the Grey Fox. GPS lines for both will be giving out at the Captain's meeting. No fishing between the starting lines before the start.
6. All boats must be back into the Black River by 2:00PM each day or they will be disqualified. Call in your boat number on channel 68 as you enter the Black River. If you intend to stay out fishing or you are running late, please notify tournament control so we can mark you off as not in but OK. If you are towing in a boat and are late you will be able to weigh in. If you are getting towed and you are late you will be disqualified.
7. 10 rods max, No fishing in the Black River
8. The weigh in limit is a 2 man MI DNR limit for Salmon/Trout (10 Fish).  
Bonus Walleye, 1 walleye is allowed in your cooler but it will not be included in your total weight.
9. Do not remove your cooler from your boat without a tournament official present. At that time they will seal your cooler. You must have your cooler in line at the scale by 3:00PM each day. No loose ice in the cooler and water must be drained before approaching the scales. There will be a trailer to transport coolers checked in on the south side of the Black River if need.
10. It is up to you to identify your big fish entry. We will not weigh two of your fish to determine the bigger fish. If your big fish takes the lead for any class there will be a length measurement taken at that time. In the event of a tie for weight, the length will be the tie breaker.
11. In case of dangerous conditions or severe weather the tournament committee has the right to delay the start of the tournament or cancel the event. If one day is complete then the tournament will be considered complete. The start may be delayed up to 10:00 am if needed. If 4 hours of fishing is completed (start until back in Black river) then the day will count as a day fished.
12. Your team's waiver should be turned in at the Captain's meeting. If the waiver isn't turned in your boat will not receive a morning cooler check and will be disqualified.
