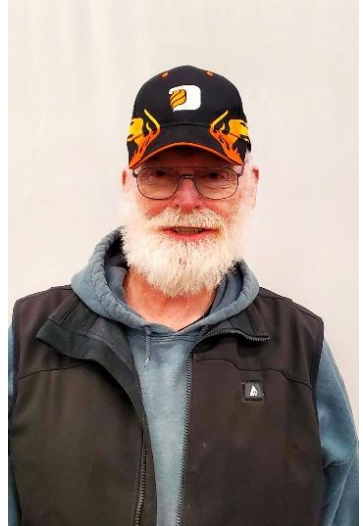
Natalino Xuereb, *Customer, paperhanger*
