A few items will be updated as we all deal with this ever evolving situation in this memo.

June 26, 2020

Mayor Breed announces delaying of reopening of certain businesses that were to open Monday, June 30<sup>th</sup>, due to concerns over spike in COVID-19 cases during a 24-hour period.

**What this means for SF Juniors?** If San Francisco continues to surge in additional COVID-19 cases, it can be expected that some activities will be discontinued, including this camp and any future camps. The Shelter in Place for residents of San Francisco is still in effect.

Reminder to all attendees of SF Juniors Summer Camp:

1. If you attend or planning to attend another sports camp, we ask that you DO NOT register or attend the SF Juniors Camp
2. **Beginning Monday, June 30<sup>th</sup>, ALL camp attendees will be asked to wear a face covering. SF Juniors has issued face covers to all participants and staff**
3. Social distancing during camp breaks is a mandatory rule
4. SF Juniors Summer Camp reserves the right to adjust and execute camp curriculum as desired to keep participants and staff safe This includes:
  - a. Dividing the pod into sub pods and exercise the use of the STM yard to maintain the safety plan
  - b. Any injury that occurs, the pod will be asked to go outside and remain outside of the gym until such time as the injured participant has been taken off the court and any sanitizing has been completed

The safety of our participants, staff and families of all that are interconnected with participants and staff are paramount in our mission to provide this service for the volleyball community. Another update on this camp and future camp #2 will be provided next weekend.
