## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q. I've been at university for 2 years, can I apply?**

A. Yes. It doesn't matter what stage you are at with your education. As long as you are the age of 25 or under, you are eligible to apply for a grant or bursary.

**Q. I want to take sabbatical leave to travel and broaden my knowledge. Does this qualify?**

A. As long as you are travelling for educational purposes (i.e. not a holiday) your travel qualifies to be subsidized through a grant.

**Q. I used to live in one of the mentioned parishes, but now live in student halls. Do I qualify for a grant or bursary?**

A. Possibly. As long as your main residence is still within the qualifying villages and parishes, your application will be considered.

**Q. I am 18 and have left education. Can I apply for a grant or bursary?**

A. Yes if the application is for something that will further your education, for example a day release course.
