Terms and Conditions of Exhibition

Key Dates	
Tuesday, February 11, 2020	All Artworks must be delivered to Shoalhaven Regional Gallery, 12 Berry Street, Nowra on Tuesday, February 11th 2020 between 10am- 4pm. Artworks not received within these times will be excluded from the Exhibition.
Friday, February 14, 2020	Exhibition opening. North Gallery, Shoalhaven Regional Gallery 6pm-7pm
Saturday, March 7, 2020	Exhibition closes. Last opportunity for buyers to place bid is 2pm, Saturday March 7, 2020
Monday, March 9, 2020	Artworks can be paid for and collected by winning bidders. 10am-12noon.
Tuesday, March 10, 2020	Artworks can be paid for and collected by winning bidders. 10am-12noon.
Wednesday March 11, 2020	Last day for artworks to be paid for and collected by winning bidders. 2pm-4pm
Artwork Requirements	
One Artwork	Due to space limitations, artists are invited to submit ONE artwork only.
	A diptych or triptych will be deemed as one Artwork and the total of all pieces must adhere to the size restrictions of 100cm (H) x 100cm (W) including framing.
Labels	All submitted artworks must have a label attached to the artwork: Artist full name Title of the artwork Medium Dimensions Artists phone number Artist mailing address
Who can enter artworks?	Those donating artworks do <u>NOT</u> have to be a member of Shoalhaven Art Society. All artists are encouraged to enter an art work.
Exhibiting fee	There will be NO fee charged to the artist for exhibiting an artwork.
Theme	There is no set theme for the donated artworks.
Maximum Size	Two dimensional Artworks must not exceed 100cm (H) x 100cm (W) (including frame); Three dimensional Artworks must not exceed 60cm (H) x 60cm (W) x 60cm (D) (including base); and Artworks must not exceed 10kg in weight.

	Please note: the size restrictions will be strictly adhered to.
Donations/ Reserve price	The artwork exhibited by the artist is considered a donation. There will be no reserve price for the silent auction.
Hanging	All artworks MUST be ready to hang with TWO D-rings secured 10cm from the top of each work. Artworks may be framed or unframed. Works with wet paint will not be accepted.
Omission of artworks	The exhibition curator will evaluate the Artwork for inclusion in the Exhibition in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. Due to the public location, Artworks must be suitable for viewing by all age groups. If the Curator decides that the Artwork is not accepted for inclusion, the Artist will be contacted to arrange for collection of the Artwork. The Curator's decision on inclusion is final and is not the subject of appeal.
Unsold works	Works that have not received a bid will be returned to the artist.
Promotional material	By entering their Artwork for inclusion in the Exhibition, the Artist agrees to allow the Shoalhaven Art Society and associated organisations to: • Reproduce, publish and display the Artwork, in full or in part, for use in any non-commercial promotional materials and publications, including promotions of future art exhibitions; • Publish the Artist's name, Artwork title and artist statement provided by the Artist in connection with their Entry; and • Provide the media with photos and information about the Artwork and Artist for the purpose of promoting or reporting on the Exhibition or Award recipients.
Transport of artworks	Artists are responsible for the transport and packing of their Artworks for delivery, including all associated costs, plus the transport of their unsold Artwork from the Exhibition.
Unclaimed artworks	Any artwork not collected within the specified timeframe shall be dealt with at the discretion of Shoalhaven Art Society. If the Artist or purchaser cannot be contacted within one month following the closing of the Exhibition, uncollected Artworks will become the property of the Shoalhaven Art Society and may be disposed of at its discretion.
Insurance of artworks	Insurance of Artworks while in transit is the Artist's responsibility. Whilst all care is taken, Shoalhaven Art Society will have no responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged artworks.
Monies raised	
Silent Auction	Each exhibited artwork will be displayed with an artist label. Patrons are invited to submit a 'silent bid' for an artwork by nominating the artist's name, title of the work and the price they would like to 'bid' on a bidders slip. The slip of paper is then deposited in a locked box. At the end of the exhibition the highest bid for each artwork will be tallied by members of the Shoalhaven Art Society and the buyer with the highest bid will be the successful bidder. The successful bidder will be notified of their successful bid at the end of the exhibition and will be expected to pay for the work upon pick up.
Donation of monies raised	Shoalhaven Art Society will donate ALL monies raised as a result of sales generated by the silent auction of donated artworks will be split equally to the following organisations.
