- Uphold Islamic values, show mutual respect, and maintain professionalism.
- Exercise confidentiality and discretion with sensitive matters.
- Work collaboratively for the unity, growth, and well-being of the ISSB community.

- Support strategic planning and long-term vision for ISSB.
- Engage with the community to understand concerns and represent their interests fairly and sincerely.
