



Frittata Recipe

Ingredients:

Basic Frittata Recipe:

6 large eggs, use 8 eggs for a 12-inch skillet

1/4 cup unsweetened almond milk, or any milk

2 garlic cloves, minced

1/4 tsp. sea salt, more for sprinkling

Freshly ground black pepper

Extra-virgin olive oil, for drizzling

Variation #1 Broccoli Feta (pictured)

6 scallions, chopped

2 cups chopped broccoli or broccolini

1/8 tsp. smoked paprika

1/4 cup crumbled feta cheese

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 400°F.
- 2. Whisk the eggs, almond milk, garlic, and salt until well combined. Set aside.
- 3. Broccoli Feta: Heat 1 tablespoon olive oil in a 10 or 12-inch cast-iron skillet over medium heat. Add the scallions, broccoli, and a pinch of salt and pepper and cook, stirring occasionally, until the broccoli is tender but still bright green, 5 to 8 minutes. Stir in the smoked paprika, then add the egg mixture and gently shake the pan to distribute. Sprinkle with the feta and bake 15 to 20 minutest or until the eggs are set. Season to taste and serve.
