
### Quilt Retreat Time Again

Sunday morning will be dedicated to a group project of Sharing Gifts Quilts.


I hope you can join in all the fun, chatting and productive, uninterrupted guilting hours!



# Leslie's Favorite Pea Soup

When I was young my mom would make this soup after we had a holiday meal of ham. I couldn't get enough of this soup, it was so delicious, right down to my soul.

### Ingredients:

Ham Bone

Water to cover ham bone

1 to 2 cups dried green peas

1 onion chopped

1 bay leaf

Salt & pepper to taste

Two grated carrots

3 med or 2 large potatoes cut into small pieces

#### **Directions:**

- In a large pot add ham bone and enough water to cover the bone. Add dried green peas, onion and bay leaf. Season with salt and pepper.
- 2. Boil to death. In an hour or so add carrots and potatoes. Don't let it stick, it burns easy.
- 3. When peas are potatoes are tender, remove bone and bay leaf.
- 4. Serve with warm buns.
