### Binding Strip Tool

Are you struggling with getting your binding to finish nicely on your quilt and what about getting neat mitred corners.

Karen Brown from Just Get It Done Quilts has a 3 in 1 Binding Tool that I have found to be so useful.

It looks like this:

2.5inches wide

Align with edge of binding strip

1/4" mark



Karen has a YouTube video where she explains how to make and use a binding strip template.

The binding strip template is attached on page 18 of the newsletter. Print out the template at 100% to ensure

accuracy. I printed mine onto paper and traced it onto a thin Dollar store cutting mat to make a plastic template. Cut it out and use per the instructions in the video. It works great!

#### **Chicken Tostadas**

In the amazing guild library I found two books - Homestyle Quilts and Simple Christmas Tidings which have easy and quick recipes for dinner, desserts, snacks and crafts. Kim Diehl and Laurie Baker wrote them.

#### You will need:

4 boneless. skinless chicken breasts, cut into chunks
16 oz. jar of picante Sauce (salsa)
10 tostada shells
1 16 oz. can of refried beans
2 tablespoons of water
Shredded cheese, lettuce, chopped tomato, guacamole, onions, and sour cream (optional)

#### **Directions:**

Place the chicken in a slow cooker and cover with the picante sauce (salsa). Cook on low for 4 to 6 hours or until the chicken shreds easily. Pour the chicken mixture in a strainer to eliminate the liquid but retain the larger chunks of picante sauce. Return the mixture to the slow cooker and use two forks to shred the chicken. Follow the package instructions to warm the tostada shells in the oven. Meanwhile, heat the refried beans and water in a small saucepan until warmed through and spreadable; add more water if necessary. Spread each tostada shell with refried beans, and then top with the shredded chicken mixture. Garnish with cheese, lettuce, tomato. guacamole, onions, and sour cream if desired. ### Block of the Month Update


