**Public Synopsis of Disciplinary Action  
January 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019**

The New Jersey Attorney General Guideline governing police internal affairs directs that each police agency shall periodically release a brief synopsis of all complaints where a fine or suspension of ten days or more was assessed to a member of the agency. The synopsis shall not contain the identities of the officers of the complainants.

From January 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019, the Trenton Police Department investigated and imposed the following penalties on its members:

- One member is suspended without pay indefinitely due to a criminal investigation where the member was charged with one count aiding and abetting one another to deprive a man of his civil rights (Title 18, USC 242) and one count of obstruction (Title 18, USC 1519). The criminal case is pending with the United States Attorney's Office.
