<sup>11</sup>For in this way there will be richly provided for you an entrance into the eternal  
kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

<sup>12</sup>Therefore I intend always to remind you of these qualities, though you know  
them and are established in the truth that you have. <sup>13</sup>I think it right, as long as I am  
in this body, to stir you up by way of reminder, <sup>14</sup>since I know that the putting off of  
my body will be soon, as our Lord Jesus Christ made clear to me. <sup>15</sup>And I will make

every effort so that after my departure you may be able at any time to recall these things.

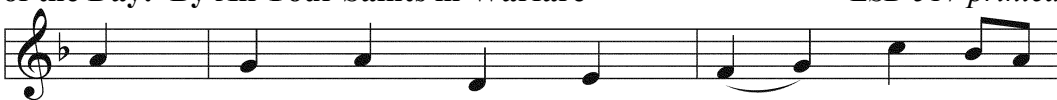

## Nicene Creed
