1 Timothy – A Pastor's Marching Orders

The next book of the New Testament is 1 Timothy, the first of what are called the "Pastoral Epistles". The two letters to Timothy, along with the letter to Titus, aren't addressed to congregations but



rather to two young pastors. Yet, in reality, these letters are for the whole church, because in them Paul sets out what pastors are supposed to be doing, and he also sets out the types of challenges that might arise in a congregation. Thus we learn even today what we here at Trinity ought to be doing and what we ought to avoid.

1 Timothy gets read fairly often. There is the famous "Chief of Sinners" passage (1:15-16). Chapter 2 begins with a lovely discourse on prayer. Chapter 3 gives the qualifications for a bishop and for a deacon.

However, for today, I'd like to focus on a theme that runs throughout the book. 1:18-19a reads, "This charge I entrust to you, Timothy, my child, in accordance with the prophecies previously made about you, that by them you may wage the good warfare, holding faith and a good conscience." Timothy gets focused on two things, faith and a good conscience.

By "faith" here, Paul isn't talking just about how much Timothy believes, but rather what he believes. The faith. The teachings. The truth. Timothy, as a pastor, is going to have to focus on sound doctrine and teaching. He has to teach the Word of God in its fullness. Over and against all the false teachers, the truth of the Gospel of Jesus must be proclaimed.

This is for the sake of a "good conscience." This is a phrase from the scripture that we have a hard time understanding today. Now, when we think of conscience, we think of Jiminy Cricket – we think of a voice telling you what's right and wrong. That's not what Paul is speaking to here. In the ancient world, your "conscience" was your awareness of how your relationship with another was. It was your knowledge (science) of how things were with (con) another person.

The only way we know that we have a good relationship, a clean conscience with God isn't on the basis of what we do, but rather the Word declaring what Jesus has done for us with His death and resurrection. So Timothy's job is to be focused on the faith, proclaiming what Jesus has done – so that he and his congregation know they are right with God and don't get twisted off into some erroneous path.

The same thing holds today for us. We are to be focused on Jesus and what He has done, so that we know that we are forgiven, so that we have and enjoy life in His name. So take a gander at the book this month, and see how everything is designed to keep us focused on Jesus.

However, we had a lot of help, and those folks are deserving of credit too! Many thanks go to Ruth Kruse and Debbie Witheft for their help managing the receptions afterwards. We are especially grateful for your help cleaning up the parish hall while we took down decorations and other items set out for the big day. Brian Noffke was also instrumental in the day's success. Not only did he set up and take down all the (often awkward and heavy) audio and visual equipment, but he also handled the risers and extra tables. Diane Hart played an important role on the evening of graduation, serving as a set of eyes and hands in the

It's a wonderful feeling to go to work and know that whatever may be happening in the world, whatever differences people may have, God's love is being poured out in every direction here at Trinity. I hope it brings everyone reading this the same joy and peace it brings me.
