

Development gone wrong. Not right, but left

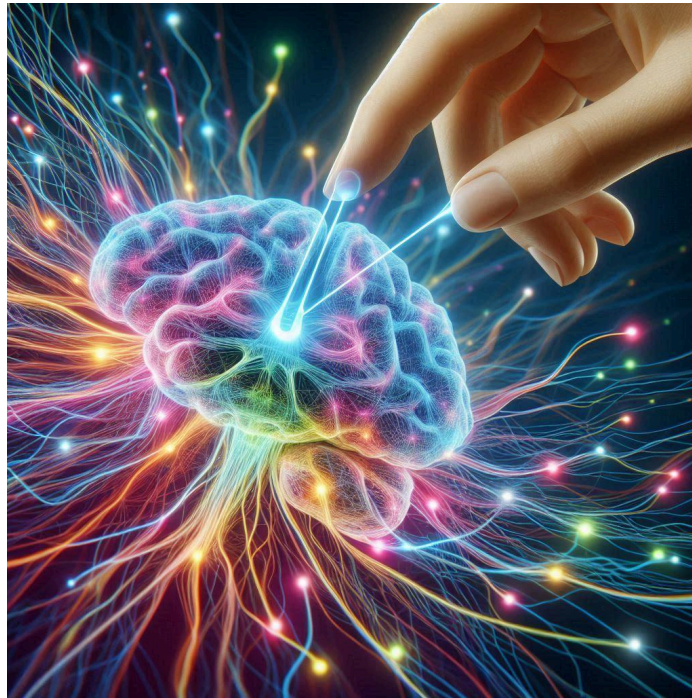


Illustration: Is there a difference in what a child can comprehend vs. an adult?
