An experiment:

Here is a list of people, divided in two different sections. Government officials (paid by tax money) and private sector (personal relation). This is of course regarding how Norway and Norwegians behave when it comes to children and future generations, and why it should be brought up as a thinking situation for social anthropologists.

The experiment follows with two questions for further reflection:

- If you were to give consequences, in the same position as a useless and incompetent Norwegian judge (which there are plenty of in this country), would you distinguish between the private sector and public sector? Lobbyism and non-contacts?
- What makes the system made-based decisions at a higher hierarchy level than private level?
