How Time seem to operate, an introduction




Why do you think it is possible to travel back and forth in time? Will you see what actually happened in the past?

With this document, you might reconsider your relation and experience regarding Time.




Following illustrations might make it clearer for the human mind. Time, a theory, might make it clearer for you.
