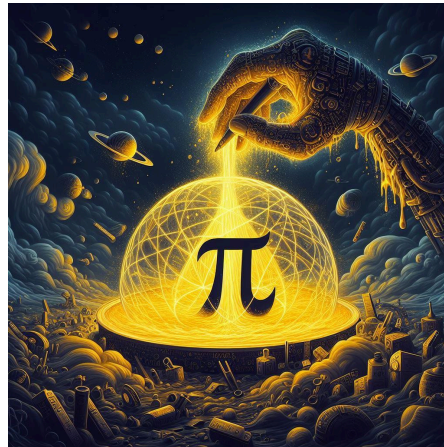


Pi as the universal layer
