

The point of construction

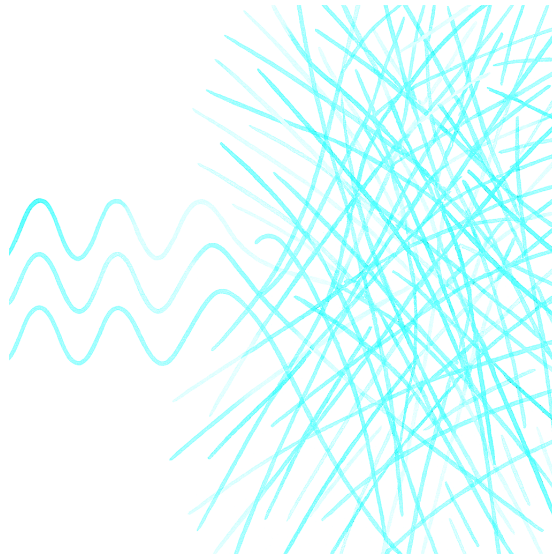


Illustration: the threshold for when consciousness weighs more than matter, is chaos. Thoughts two the left, environment to the right
