The 2026 California Licensing Roadmap

Your 7-step path to an insurance license under AB 943 — no wasted hours.

AB 943 eliminated the old 52-hour prelicensing requirement on January 1, 2026. Here's the entire path now:

- 1 Choose your license line** ☐
Property & Casualty, Life, Accident & Health/Sickness, or Personal Lines. Not sure which fits your goals? That's a 10-minute conversation with us — call before you apply.
- 2 Complete the 12-Hour Code & Ethics course — with us** ☐
The ONLY required prelicensing since AB 943 (includes 1 hour on insurance fraud). We teach it — included in our 6-Day Pass Track (\$589) along with complete exam preparation.
- 3 Schedule your state exam** ☐
Exams are administered by PSI for the California Department of Insurance. You can sit for the exam before finishing Code & Ethics — but your license won't issue until it's done.
- 4 Prepare to pass — the FIRST time** ☐
AB 943 didn't change the exam: same questions, 60% to pass. One Day Cram (\$329) is one focused day built around exactly what the state tests. The hours are gone; the gatekeeper isn't.
- 5 Pass the exam** ☐
Walk in prepared, walk out passed. Your PSI result is reported to the CDI.
- 6 Get fingerprinted (Live Scan)** ☐
Required for your background check. Keep your receipt — you'll reference it in your application.
- 7 Apply for your license on Sircon** ☐
Submit your license application online at sircon.com. With your exam passed, Code & Ethics complete, and prints on file, the CDI issues your license — and you're in business.

Two ways to get there — both end with you licensed.
