Job Title: Teacher-Tutor (TT) for Reading and Mathematics

Position Description:

Part-time teacher-tutor for MI-RAMP who exhibit a passion for teaching and an expertise in the content areas of Mathematics or Reading. The teacher-tutor will be responsible for planning and implementing high-quality instruction to all students in an individualized and private, 1:1, format (plus parent involvement).

Preferred Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree level or above
- Experience teaching in an elementary or middle school setting (and/or Pre-K)
- Strong communication skills
- Ability to use student achievement data to steer instruction
- Knowledge of best practices
- Applicants must be able to apply current educational knowledge to design and implement an effective curriculum for mathematicians and reading at the appropriate grade level.
- Reliable and punctual attendance is an essential job responsibility
- Contribute to a professional environment that is one of mutual respect, teamwork, and accountability

TT's will be paid \$30 per hour, preferably teaching students on the weekends (30 minutes of contact time per student per week). Additionally, you will be compensated \$30 per hour for prep time per week, if the number of students is 4 or more, but \$15 per hour if the number of students is less than 4.
