3) Executive committee members – Bob Schippnick

- Chris Little and Jerry Pagac have resigned their positions on the Executive Committee, yet will serve as non-voting consultants as needed. Bob Hall raised concerns about whether Chris Little and Jerry Pagac are qualified members based on Articles V & VI of the by-laws, which seem to be inconsistent as to whether Executive Committee members who are not the primary officers must be members of the board. Bob Hall noted that Bob Holt is not the "immediate" past president as the by-laws require. Comments in response noted that he is the only available past president to fill the position.

- Articles V & VI were suggested for subsequent review and potential revision at a later date to clarify intent.

4) Security Contract – Bob Schippnick

- The contract with Hinds Security expires on Dec 31, 2016. The Executive Committee recommends exercising the option for 3-yr extension of the current security contract with Hinds Security for 2017-2019, with a \$-0- increase for 2017, a 1% increase for 2018, and a 1% increase for 2019. PSA must notify hinds Security no later than Oct 31 of intention to extend or not.

5) Sale of Eagle Pointe Golf Resort Status Update – Bob Schippnick

- 2015 Project Amendment & 2016 Agreements were prepped for final signatures. 2015 carryover must be used by 12/31/16. Waiting on closure of sale.
- Thompson expressed interest in working with PSA if sale falls through. Schippnick emailed Bobby
 Thompson on 6/22 describing the necessary procedures for developing any new potential agreement.
- Schippnick has facilitated conversations between parties. Participants are still talking and taking
 positive steps toward a closing in early Aug. Schippnick sent message to BoD on 7/10 for distribution to
 homeowners through the village boards, noting that the two parties are talking, but still have some
 issues to discuss and documentation to complete and assemble.
- 7/15 email for distribution to homeowners noted that some reports were complete, the building inspection is scheduled for 7/18, and both parties have agreed to a closing date of 8/5.
- Glenn—do we have a "Plan B"? Propose that PSA consider purchase as Plan B.

6) Treasurer's Report- Michele Hardman

- CASI Financial Reports sent Mar/Apr/May to BoD on 7/9
- 2017 Proposed DRAFT Budget & Highlights BoD will vote on 2017 Budget at Oct mtg.
- Budget discussion & edits:
 - o Operating Income should reflect 2016 transfer of \$20k to road repair reserve
 - Reserve Exp: change title of 9916 from "paved surface expense" to "road repair/improvement"
 - State plan for road reserves and expense (whole main road resurface & striping from gate 1 to
 5.
 - State plan for main guard remodel (gut inside & start over).
- Rental assessments (\$100 annually) for calendar year 2015 to be sent out in the next few weeks.

7) PSA Community TV Update-George Hopstetter

- Requests for service have increased, especially after Smithiville's connections fees went up to \$300.
- Acquiring equipment and supplies necessary for the tower work to help stabilize reception. Have
 identified a tower climber to do the work. Tower property is owned by EPGR. Cannot proceed until the
 EPGR sale closes.
- Difficulty finding qualified people to help connect and troubleshoot re-connects. Potential additional installer-Mavin Alfonzo.
- Once tower work is complete, we will investigate cost of adding Big 10.
- Surprisingly, about 50% of users have analog, not digital, TVs.

8) Sign Repairs & replacements-George Hopstetter

• LED lighting on Villages Sign – lights purchased & on-hand. Waiting on underground lines to be marked before installation. Should be complete by end of July.

• Concerns about golf cart crossings (Bernstein & Swift-Hanlon – Exec Comm authorized improved signage: bigger sign to direct visitors away from gate 5 to main guard house; signs for all crossings, more distinct visitor signs.

9) Guard House Upgrades-Pagac

- Gate 5 Guard House: 3 quotes in. Vendor selected. Power wash; new roof, facia, sofit, gutters, toilet, blinds, & cleaning. To start next week.
- Request for scope and bids.

10) Road Projects 2016-Bob Holt

- Sluice repair calling excavating companies, 1 quote in-hand. Project scope description.
- Bob Holt will review repair plans for standing water near guard house at Slaven property
- Shrub covering big rock sign—cut by 2/3, may replace with smaller shrubs.

11) Strategic Planning-Chris Littel

Chris developed ideas for strategic plan that must wait on closure of property sale.

12) Security Update-Bob Schippnick

- Parking/towing policy –DRAFT proposal presented. Will call for e-vote. (Subsequently tabled until Oct mtg)
- Discussed enforcement of stickers & passes; calling-in guests
