PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELLING SERVICES

Applies to the provision of services (excluding NDIS / enhanced care) via all platforms, including in-person and telehealth. Psychological counselling services are delivered as **50-minute** consultations.

ENHANCED CARE PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

Applies to the provision of services that require longer or more comprehensive sessions, including in-person and telehealth. Services are delivered as **60-minute** consultations and include additional time for documentation, care coordination, treatment planning/monitoring and reporting requirements where applicable.

Requests for psychological reports and professional support letters will be considered by the Psychologist, but acceptance is not guaranteed. Requests should be made 2 - 4 weeks in advance. Fees are per hour.
