

Grandwatt Electric Corporation warrants to the original Purchaser that the product stated below will be free of defects for the time period indicated. If the product should have a defect within the time indicated Grandwatt Electric Corporation will be responsible for the repair, adjustment, or replacement of the product. Grandwatt Electric Corporation has the authority to determine if this warranty covers the defect or malfunction. The defect will not be covered by Grandwatt Electric Corporation if occurred due to improper installation, physical damage, repairs or service by unauthorized persons, misuse, or normal wear and tear. Grandwatt Electric Corporation will inspect the product making sure that the product has been installed, maintained and operated in accordance to Grandwatt Electric Corporations product manual. This warranty is only valid to the original consumer.

Grandwatt Electric Corporation shall not be liable for any claim amount that is greater than the finalized purchase price of the product. In no event shall Grandwatt Electric Corporation be held liable for any special, indirect, consequential or liquidated damages.

Grandwatt Electric Corporation parts and labor product warranty period is from the date of factory invoice covering the first one (1) year or until the product reaches 1000 hours, whichever term comes first. Accessories that are installed on the product or shipped loose will be covered under this parts and labor warranty for one (1) year from the date of factory invoice or until 1000 hours, whichever comes first

All service work on a Grandwatt Electric Corporation product must be completed by an authorized Grandwatt Electric Corporation Service Provider. To obtain service under this warranty contact Grandwatt Electric Corporation or an authorized Grandwatt Electric Corporation Dealer. (See contact Information Below) This warranty will become void if service is performed on the product by persons not authorized service employees of Grandwatt Electric Corporation.

THERE ARE NO EXPRESS WARRANTIES OTHER THAN THOSE DESCRIBED HERIN. THERE ARE NO OTHER WARRANTIES OBLIGATING GRANDWATT ELECTRIC CORPORATION OTHER THAN STATED IN THIS WARRANTY. GRANDWATT ELECTRIC CORPORATION MAKES ALL FINAL DECISIONS.

The following items and/or circumstances are EXCLUDED from this limited warranty.

- Normal Maintenance items: Consumable items such as light bulbs, capacitors, belts, filters, and hoses
- Adjustments and tune-ups performed during start up or thereafter.
- Loose connection (electrical and mechanical) not found during start up.
- Fuel system and/or governing system adjustments performed during start up.
- Engine starting batteries. The battery manufacturers' warrants apply. Consult your local battery supplier.
- Equipment modifications made without the written consent of Grandwatt Electric Corporation will void all warranties.
- Improper installation or operation as outlined in the Installation and Operation Manuals.
- Damages caused by acts of nature, such as lightening, wind, flood, or earthquake.
- Shipping damage of any type. Grandwatt Electric Corporation is no longer responsible for shipping damage once the product is loaded to the carrier. The receiver is responsible for checking all product from the carrier for damage, noting, and signing the receipt. Grandwatt Electric Corporation will not warrant any damage to the unit resulting from shrink wrap.
- Any special access fees, requirements or after hours scheduling to gain access to the equipment for warranty service purposes.
- Owners requested rental products used while warranty servicing is being performed.
- All travel labor and mileage on portable equipment must be approved before any work is performed.
- Diesel engine "Wet Stacking" due to lightly loaded diesel engines.
- Any damage due to situations beyond the control of the manufacturing and/or workmanship of the product.

The start of the warranty period can be adjusted to the date of the unit start-up (limited to 180 days from invoice date provided that the following information be submitted to Grandwatt Electric Corporation. (1) A copy of the Grandwatt Electric Corporation start up validation checklist must be properly and completely filled out and returned within 30 days of start-up. (2) The engine manufacturer's engine registration form must be completed and returned to the engine manufacturer with the registration form.

Terms of warranty shall be deemed made and executed in Suffolk, VA. Venue for all legal proceedings shall be in Suffolk, VA.
