2016 was a year of success on many levels for us, and I am pleased to report that The Scituate Animal Shelter continues to be the premier animal welfare organization south of Boston.

Last year, we found homes for 552 cats, dogs, bunnies and a few other four legged friends, up significantly from 440 in 2015. Additionally, SAS continues to be a valuable resource for our communities, providing affordable medical care through spay/neuter clinics and comprehensive humane education.

Improving the lives of animals and their families doesn't happen without sound planning and hard work. We are fortunate to have talented staff and volunteers that perform all the necessary activities in running a shelter: direct animal care, client service, fundraising, and managing the HELP program, to name a few. In 2016, we were excited to add Maryann Regan as Executive Director of SAS, bringing significant experience and energy to an excellent team.

Our organization will be celebrating its 25th anniversary in 2017. It is amazing to consider the positive impact we've had on countless animals over the years. I am thankful to those that recognized the need for the Shelter and showed commitment to make it a reality. Their kindness is an inspiration that drives us all to continue this important work.

OUR HUMANE REACH

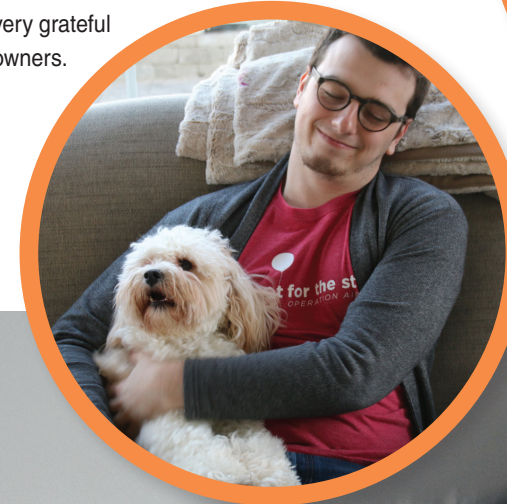
We found homes for 552 pets in 2016, but we aren't just a shelter. We are the region's preeminent resource for Massachusetts animals.

"Helping" keep best friends together.

Our H.E.L.P. program and our informal pet food pantry provide aid and resources to senior pet owners and those facing financial hardship, allowing them to care for their beloved pets in their own homes.

Reuniting lost pets.

In 2016, we reunited 75 lost dogs and cats with their very grateful owners.



Low cost community vaccination and spay/neuter clinics.

Financial hardship is a major reason that pets are surrendered or abandoned. We are a resource for the region's pet owners, helping to provide affordable care that can keep animals out of shelters.



› 2016 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

We hired an Executive Director.

A strong organization needs leadership to thrive. Thus, **Maryann Regan** joined SAS this year after a broad search led



by a team comprised of Board members, shelter volunteers and financial supporters.

Previously Director of Shelter Operations for The Animal Rescue League of Boston, Maryann holds a Masters in Community Leadership, a certificate in Non-Profit Management from Boston University's Questrom School of Business, and served on the Board of the

We dramatically boosted animal adoptions.

Adoptions at our Shelter increased dramatically for the fourth consecutive year, translating to a record 552 animals homed in 2016, a tremendous leap over the previous year's record of 440 pets.

We cultivated crucial relationships with corporate partners.

We made progress towards a strategic goal of increasing our percentage of corporate and business fundraising support in 2016, including conducting a joint adoption and open house event with Unleashed by Petco in October.



We started a new fundraising tradition.

In August, we hosted a fundraising and public relations event, *Dine Out for Dogs and Cats*, at three South Shore restaurants. The event, which featured formerly homeless "goodwill" ambassador dogs at each location, garnered a great deal of publicity and is slated to be repeated on a larger scale in 2017.

Compassionate care for local feral and stray cat populations.

Our programs make lives better for the cats of our region. We found caring homes for 205 kittens and neutered 150 feral cats in 2016, a critical intervention given that each breeding pair could, in theory, sire up to 2,000 cats in four years.

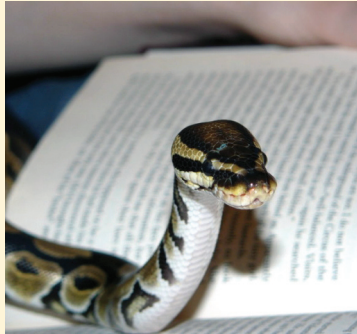
ANIMALS HELPED IN 2016

Our animals, and their stories, are diverse. Some highlights from 2016:



Meesha was found in a local state park. Her behavior—waiting by the park's entrance for days—indicated that she'd been abandoned. After testing positive for heartworm, she was transferred into a foster home to recuperate, and subsequently adopted by her foster family who decided they couldn't part with her.

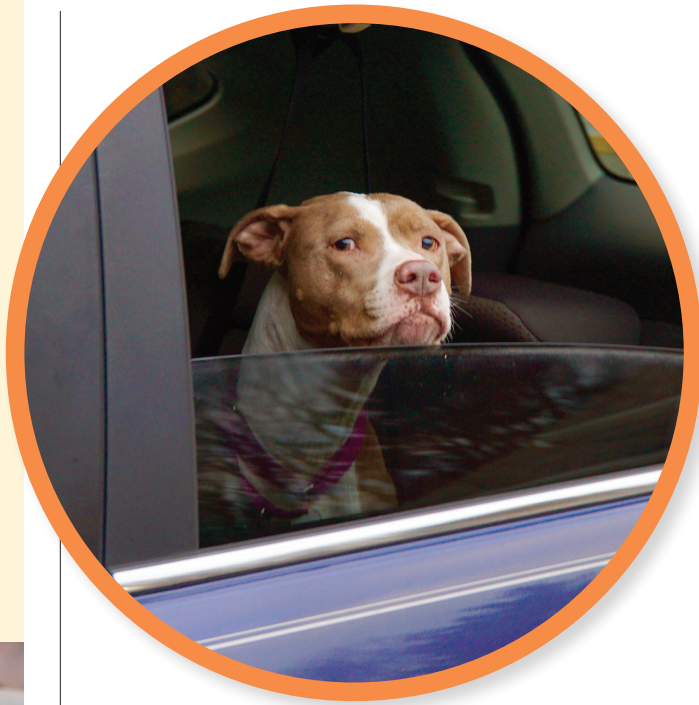
Marguerite, a pet Ball Python, was found curled in a tree, trying to survive outdoors—not an easy feat for a snake native to sub-Saharan Africa. Rescued by a good samaritan, she was adopted by a teacher and is now a classroom pet.



Camry and Corolla were born to a feral mom and exhibited the shy and fearful temperament typical of “stray” kittens. Since experts believe it is best for feline development for kittens to be adopted in pairs, they were adopted together in July 2016.

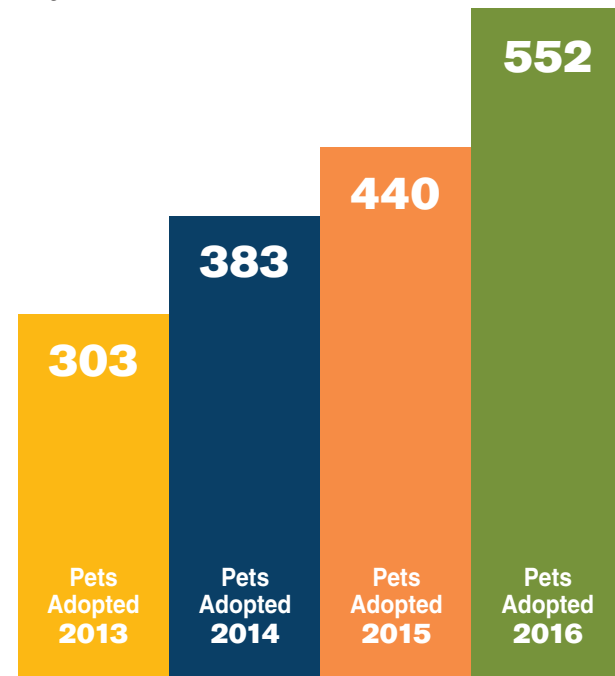


Maisy was the Shelter's first pet hedgehog, surrendered because she wasn't getting any attention after her owner went to college. She was adopted by a vet tech at a local practice.



ADOPTIONS

Our shelter found homes for 552 animals in 2016, continuing a 4-year trend of increased adoption numbers each year. Our animals come from every corner of Massachusetts, coming to us as strays, as transfers from other shelters or animal control facilities, or as surrenders from owners no longer able to care for them.



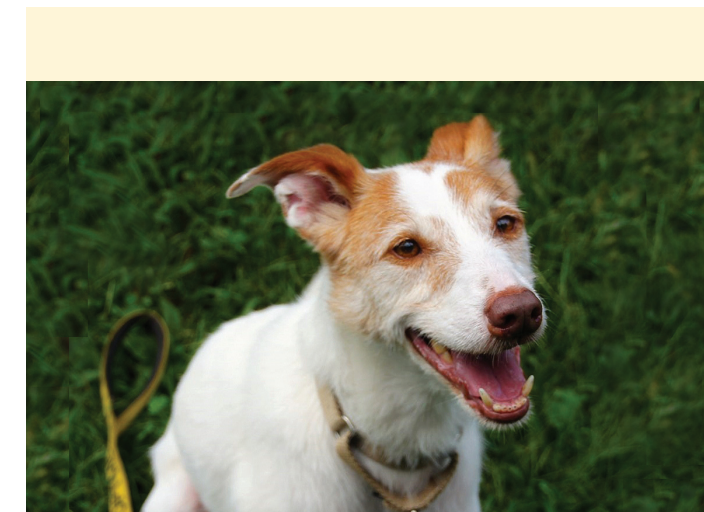
FINANCIAL DATA

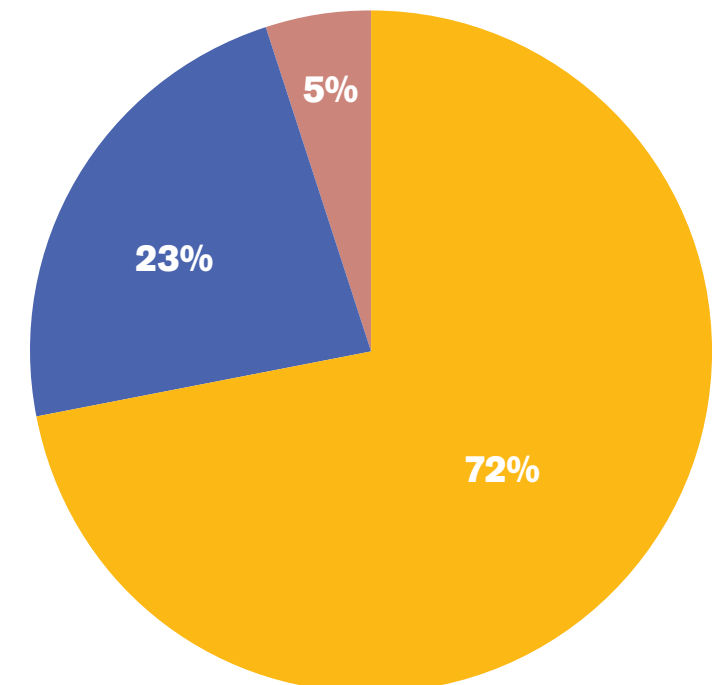

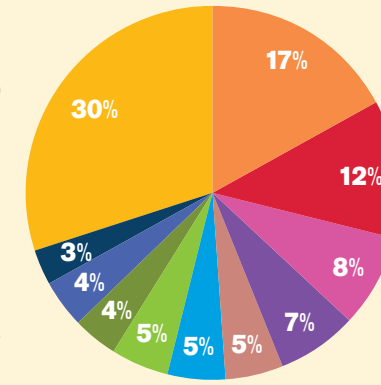

One of our most shared stories of 2016 involved five neglected dogs who each found new families with us, but not before receiving extreme “makeovers.”

One dog can be a handful. But five? That can be completely overwhelming. That was the situation for a South Shore resident who allowed his un-neutered Shih Tzu mix dogs to have puppies, and then found himself unable to care for five dogs with frequent grooming needs.

When the dogs were surrendered to the Shelter in March, they were matted, filthy and had painfully overgrown nails. Munchkin, the smallest and shyest of the group, had even developed significant mobility issues due to the severely matted fur on her legs.

The dogs received much-needed haircuts, grooming, and baths, plus physical therapy and overdue veterinary care, including crucial neutering surgeries. All five were quickly adopted, including Munchkin who has since served as a “Canine Ambassador” at SAS-related public events.

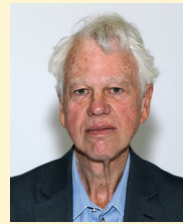
