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Scope of this policy

1. RECCE Site Investigation Limited uses cookies when you visit our website, <https://www.recce-si.co.uk> to help customise the website and improve your experience using our website.

3. When you visit the website, you will be presented with a cookie consent banner allowing you to accept, reject or customise your cookie preferences. Non-essential cookies will only be placed on your device where you have provided your consent.

What are cookies?

1. A cookie is a small text file placed on your computer by this website when you visit certain parts of the website and/or when you use certain features of the website.

Type of Cookie	Purpose

Analytical / Performance cookies	These cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. Functionality cookies	These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region). By using the website, you agree to our placement of functionality cookies.
