Rain and/or moderate rain showers encroach from the north & west Mon evening into Tue.

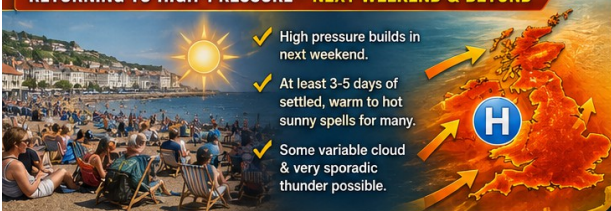
Another front brings much-needed rain to southern areas Tue night into Wed.

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The upcoming week will therefore begin and stay warm across parts of the south as earlier indicated, with increasing and variable cloud cover and some quite close-feeling weather from across parts of the north and west.

Additionally, rain and or moderate rain showers will also encroach from the north and west during later Monday evening and before spreading into some parts of central and eastern England during early Tuesday.

An additional weather front will also be likely to bring some much-needed rain across southern and far southern areas during late Tuesday and/or early Wednesday, with showery or heavy showery conditions and even some thunderstorms or thundery rumbles continuing in places of nearby low pressure features, particularly in the far north and west and potentially later in parts of south-east England and throughout the remainder of the upcoming working week.

However, expected high pressure on our part once again is then likely to build and settle

things down once again during the next weekend and over at least a 3–5 day minimum period and with warm to hot sunny spells for many in among some variable cloud cover and potentially very sporadic thundery developments that will also be replaced by further and more significant changes to something much more unsettled and cooler with further and more potent thunderstorms during the final days of August and the actual end of summer 2026 in meteorologically terms.
