Just a quick one, everyone, and the latest and now repeated GFS runs x 3 seem to be identifying a push and major spike of heat and hot to even very hot weather across our shores, with some variation from run to run for many parts of the country from during the early to middle part of next week and over at least 2-4 days or possibly longer and not too far away from our last forecast update from 2 WEEKS EARLIER for in and around AUGUST 8th below (also covered the last 2 weeks since the update itself pretty much correctly and for the present forecasting period we 'currently' reside within).
