The fifth consecutive heatwave of summer is now about to get underway with mid to high 30s once again for the UK over several days and also until later next week.

From around Mon 17th August, the north returns to more normal temperatures with rain and thunderstorm possibilities, while high pressure persists in the south.

Around Aug 20-24, heat becomes more extensive again, before a significant breakdown Aug 24-27 brings widespread thunderstorms, heavy rain, hail and flooding.

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## Heatwave Number 5 Begins On Cue + When Will It End & Rain + More August Heat & When Explained...

The fifth consecutive heatwave of summer is now about to get underway with top temperatures in the mid to high 30s once again for the UK over several days and also until later next week with everywhere feeling the heat for the FIFTH time in succession on our part for the exact dates of occurrence and for much earlier than anywhere else in terms of long-range weather forecasts, weather apps, or any other weather pages (please feel free to check our posts and proof posts for yourself on this).

From and around later next weekend and into the middle of the following week, starting Monday 17th August is when we will start to see some sort of normalisation in terms of temperatures across the north and with rain and thunderstorm possibilities bubbling up.

However, high pressure will also want to continue to feature across the southern half of the country and also extend further north at times as a battle between normal and warmer to hot temperatures continues throughout the remainder of the month and as covered and forecast for in our several months ahead members and seasonal reports for August (will also be a difficult time during this period with ever-changing and non-consistent weather forecasts from elsewhere and via your apps because of these

expected developments).

Another several-day period that we could very well see this heat becoming more extensive across our shores once again is on and around August 20–24 (also covered for several months ahead for these dates in August).

However, and importantly, our same long-range weather projections for August also expect a significant breakdown of these conditions covered above for on and around August 24–27, with a heightened risk of widespread thunderstorm activity across large parts of the country, along with some potentially major flooding issues from significant rainfall amounts over some very short time periods and from some rapid rainfall amounts and even hail or heavy hail on very dry ground for the first time in a while and from the dry summer to date also heightens flooding issues too (dry ground also floods easier).

To conclude for now, this upcoming and present warmth and heat is also as covered in our now over 2-weeks ahead forecast for these exact dates of TODAY and over SEVERAL days, and also, additionally, for within our longer range summer efforts for these same dates in August:
