Staying Warm/Hot/Dry + Temporarily & Expectantly Fresher From Fri & Prior To Further High-Pressure/Heat From Sun/Mon...

Nothing much different to report from our last several updates listed below and as expected for the continued heat at present, despite a temporary change over days from around Friday and into Saturday of this week across the UK and Ireland, with a slight to moderate dropping off in overall temperatures with winds from the north that could also induce some cloudiness and hit-and-miss thunderstorms or showers at times, particularly, in some northern and eastern parts of the country, and then the expectant high-pressure on our part will return once again shortly after.

So, from on and around Sunday and Monday, we will once again see high-pressure encroaching from the west of the UK and Ireland and this will warm things up once again with the best of the sunshine and warm-to-hot temperatures building in from across parts of the west to begin the new week and as also covered in our last several updates in the provided links below for these same days and dates.

Additionally, we can still expect a breaking down of these conditions for in and around the middle to end of the next working week and more specifically for in and around July 24th, to something significantly cooler and more unsettled, with thunderstorms for many over a number of days and also, as covered in our previous updates below for these same days and dates.

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However, these changes to cooler and more unsettled for these same dates in late July and around July 24th look to be quite short-lived and over no more than around 2–5 days at most as high pressure and further warm to hot temperatures look set and favourable to return across many parts of the country during the final days of July and to begin August and the final month of the meteorological summer with another gracing and bathing of warm to hot temperatures and sunshine across our shores once again.

However, and importantly, there are likely to be some enhanced and variable cloud cover issues at times, with litters of thunderstorms or problematic thunderstorms for many the deeper we head into August and matching our several months ahead reports for this.
