ECM: Cooler & more unsettled from the north & southward over several days around July 24th.

They'll meet somewhere in between. Expect 1 to 2 days of cooler, showery weather in the north around July 24th, then high pressure rebuilds strongly.

It is also a little frustrating seeing many others taking and receiving false credit for

something they clearly never saw coming until the last minute or covered for in previous updates of their own, as we (myself/Exacta) have repeatedly forecast for these set-dates in "MID-JULY" on many occasions over several months with clear and conclusive proof to back up our claims (something others can't offer and also something I am tired of giving others the heads-up on for them to only follow suit themselves afterwards or nearer the time of the event and then wrongly taking credit for it and forecasting NOTHING).

Additionally, the heat and high pressure dominance is therefore set to continue with NO interruptions to proceedings over the weekend in terms of rain and also well into next week in terms of any rain and cooler weather conditions.

The most recent and current Global Forecast System (GFS) now wants to quash any cooler and unsettled weather around July 24th to a pretty brief affair over 11-36 hours at tops across parts of the north, and with the European Computer Model (ECM) running it quite a bit cooler and more unsettled than this from across the north and southward over several days instead for around these same dates in July.

However, and to conclude, we think they'll meet somewhere in between both of these recent projections from the GFS and ECM and instead of the high-pressure cancelling out, these expected changes to cooler with some rain and thunderstorm possibilities later next week, they will instead be likely to prevail for at least a day or two around July 24, particularly, from across parts of the north and prior to those further and continuing and expected high-pressure rises across our shores afterwards for late July and well into August.
