Some Final Warm & Even Hot Conditions To Start Next Week & End July + Cooler/Showery After & Any More Heat In August/When...

As the warmth and sun continue for now and as expected on our part, both of the latest and repeated GFS and ECM runs look to go temporarily and reasonably warm to possibly even hot in places once again from the early to the middle part of next week and for the final few days of July for around an extra 2–3 days minimum and prior to it turning 'somewhat cooler' than of late and significantly cloudier and/or muggy and more unsettled with thunderstorms afterwards but not too cool in terms of overall temperatures, and just as our much earlier reports from below said it would and along with somewhat cooler and showery conditions for many at times over this weekend and also for our longer range efforts for the 'whole of August' and what else to expect during this period that has remained unchanged to our subscribers since earlier this year (a warm and muggy August with some heat spikes for certain dates + possible thunderstorms, flooding and hail)...

Unfortunately or fortunately (depending on how you view it), the dynamics don't seem to be there at present for anything too prolonged in longevity or extreme heat, but this expected high pressure ridging will still feature in our weather and temperatures briefly

from the early to middle of next week on our part and may even intensify a little more between now and then.

Additionally, we (myself/Exacta) also never said anything about temperatures reaching 40°C at this point in the upcoming period of late July and that came from elsewhere and was clickbait from certain and shameful media companies, but we could very well see temperatures in the low 30s and mid to high 20s quite widely once again for a day or two to begin next week and prior to something more substantial building in across our shores in terms of high pressure and potentially even hotter or extreme temperatures for in and around August 8th over several days.

Please also note that confidence is moderate to high for this around August 8th and although this is currently showing and starting to feature on some of the latest GFS runs, it is not on the latest available and longer-term ECM computer model runs as yet.
