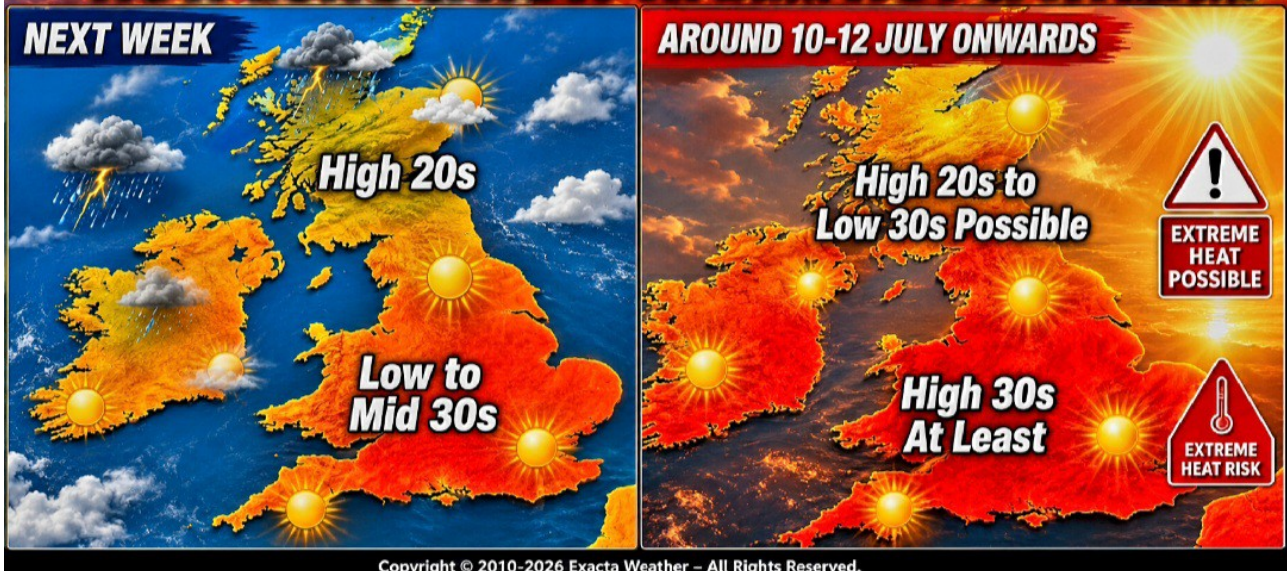

MAJOR WARM-UP BEGINS ONCE AGAIN + HOW LONG & HOW WARM/HOT & WHEN...



Major Warm-Up Begins Once Again + How Long & How Warm/Hot & When...

The warming up of conditions has officially begun with temperatures reaching very close to a hot 30°C in parts of the south during today (something not being hinted at in terms of temperatures only a few days ago from elsewhere and for into the upcoming week– see below).

These parts will also experience very similar temperatures through much of the upcoming week (maximums of 30°C+) and may even near or exceed the mid 30s by around midweek, as covered in our last updates on this below.

Additionally, parts further north and away from the south will also experience maximum and warm-to-hot temperatures in at least the high 20s during this same period and with more in the way of sunshine by midweek, although some unfortunate cloudy and muggy conditions and occasional showers or thundery

rumbles could exist at either side of this midweek period at times across those parts further north and may somewhat hamper conditions slightly in comparison to those parts further south.

However, on and around July 10-12 we are still expecting a major intensification of the high pressure and temperature rises across our shores to bring some very hot to even extreme heat over several days (high 30s at least), at the very least for most and if not all parts of the country.

Additionally, this also matches our exact dates for this exact same period and dates/days from as early as late February (see dated post below) and is also something that is now being repeated and backed up on our part by 'most' of the latest third-party ECM and GFS computer runs for around these same dates.
