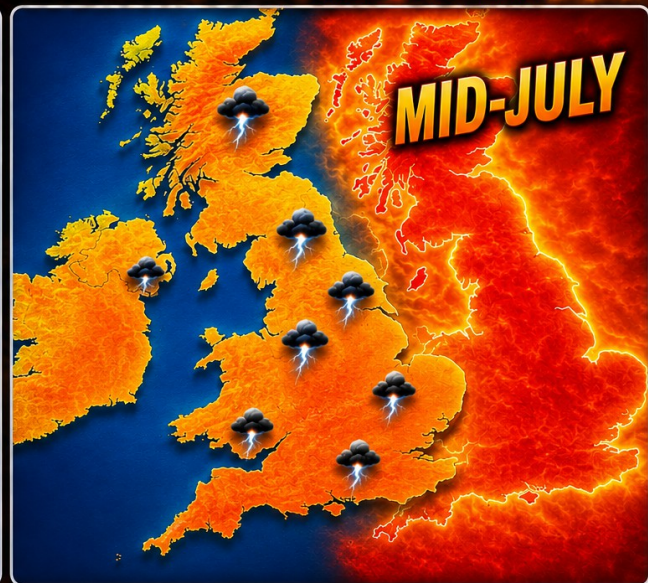

Additionally, this will then also pave the way for even more intense high pressure and temperature rises across our shores for an extended period as we head towards mid-July (Around 10-20 July and something the main third-party apps are 'starting' to show) and also matching our exact and unchanged dates in our seasonal report to subscribers from several months ahead (February 2026) that also forecast the previous warm/hot periods for the exact dates and duration in 1. Mid to late April 2. The record-breaking late May heat 3. The recent record-breaking June heat 4. The mid-July heatwave?
