There are now some repeatedly repeated very warm to very hot charts for later this week and for at least several days from around midweek (Wed/Thu) and into Friday with temperatures varying but also likely to top out in at least the mid to high 30s in the hottest parts of the country during the next upcoming weekend and also whilst turning very warm to hot elsewhere from midweek and also in many parts away from the southern half of the country and as covered in our earlier updates 'prior' to this weekend just gone in the digitally-dated links titled "High-Pressure & HEAT Never Far Away NEXT WEEK" below.

Additionally, for on and around July 10th onwards, both the Global Forecast System (GFS) and the European Computer Model (ECM) have another kind of mega heatwave building in across our shores and for our exact and unchanged several months ahead dates for this type of prolonged heat event to occur and also peak during the period of around July 10-

20th 2026 (the exact dates issued and repeated to our paid subscribers since February 2026)

Temperatures could also reach into the mid to high 30s again quite widely from such a major heat event at such a time of the year for these same dates of ours in mid-July, and it could very well be very similar to recently in terms of duration and temperatures or potentially a little longer and hotter this time around as that almost fabled 40°C or higher marker comes under question once again.
