

# EXACTAWEATHER



**New: Mixed, Cooler, & Showery With Rain/Hail & Some Sunshine + On-Cue Major High Pressure & Very Warm/Hot Weather IS On The Horizon...**

After some further brighter and relatively drier weather with sunny spells and variable cloud cover to end this week and Sunday, we will initially see these same or similar conditions continuing into Monday and to start the new working week with a moderate risk of some showery rain developing in places.

Unfortunately, we will then see the jet-stream dipping more southwards beyond this and, from around Tuesday onwards, will see low pressure dominating with showers or heavy showers being introduced across parts of the north and west to begin with, and with the better weather or any sunny periods being more reserved for more southern regions or the southern half of the country away from these developing showers and rain.

Additionally, it is likely to be cool enough for some of these showers to turn wintry across the 'highest of ground' in the far north at times from later on Sunday evening and at times into next week as the cooler and unsettled theme with cold northerly winds continues and despite it being almost summer, also continues through much of the upcoming week in the form of varying showers and possible hail and/or thundery rumbles.

Towards the end of the upcoming week, we could then see some better weather conditions being induced from the south and for other parts of the country, but with showery conditions or rain from low pressure features and numerous weather fronts

never being too far away from us to deliver, and continue with a rather mixed theme overall for many.

However, in the longer-term, there are now some increasing and quite strong and frequent signals for some major high pressure and temperature rises across our shores for in and around the final third of May over several days from both the GFS (Global Forecast System) and the ECM (European Model) for our 'exact dates' from within our several week ahead subscribers and spring/May report once again (issued all the way back in February to our subscribers).

Additionally, this also ties in very well and correctly with our overall May report for a run of cooler, unsettled and mixed conditions after the prolonged high pressure dominance over weeks from earlier in April and early May and also for the 'exact dates' on our part once again, in addition to the pending very warm to very hot weather and temperatures we are also expecting on our part during late May and for in and around the 'start dates' of May 22-25.

So, just to clarify, that is all the following from just recent weather events as part of our spring 2026 forecast issued in FEBRUARY!!!

1. Major and prolonged high pressure rises over weeks from mid to late April ✓
2. A more mixed and cooler weather pattern with some settled weather for much of May from around early May ✓
3. A significant and major high pressure rise across our shores during the final third of May for our exact dates once again ?
