Doubtful Sound - Commentary by our knowledgeable skipper and nature guide - Wildlife viewing opportunities, including dolphins, fur seals and even occasionally penguins - Snacks and drinks available for purchase onboard Doubtful Sound is a beautiful fiord; three times longer than Milford Sound and a surface area ten times larger with twisting arms. With its rugged peaks, verdant rainforest and twisting, hidden inlets, Doubtful Sound will take your breath away.

There's no direct road access, so the only way you can get to Doubtful Sound is a cruise across the picturesque Lake Manapouri, followed by a bus trip over Wilmot Pass - New Zealand's most expensive (and majestic) road. Pause along the way to experience the dense Fiordland rainforest and view Doubtful Sound glistening below. This isolation makes this fiord a very special place, only those in the know get to see. Once you arrive, you will board the Patea Explorer for a 3-hour (approximately) cruise on Doubtful Sound - a spectacular pristine fiord. During the cruise, the knowledgeable and friendly skipper or nature guide will share with you their passion for the region.

They're always ready to answer questions, point out landmarks and provide all the information about the varied wildlife you may see, including dolphins, fur seals, and the rare Fiordland crested penguins. **Overnight in Queenstown. QT Queenstown Hotel or similar.**

Rotorua Meal Breakfast Te Ra Guided Experience + Haka Cultural



Performance Our tradition of guiding at Te Puia is something that we pride ourselves on. Many of the guides you meet can link themselves to Rotorua's earliest guides and the stories they relay have been handed down for generations. Overnight [Novotel Rotorua](#) or similar.

Te Heketanga Ō Rangi (heavenly origins) - Your tour begins at the main entrance, where twelve monumental carvings reach skywards, representing twelve celestial guardians. Discover stories of our ancestors' arrival and settlement in Rotorua at our world class exhibition gallery at Te Puia.

Kiwi House - See our New Zealand flightless bird in a specially lit kiwi house with kiwi specialist guides at hand.

Te Whakarewarewa Thermal Valley - Explore our unique geothermal reserve with thermal activity ranging from boiling mud pools to the world famous 30 metre (100 foot) Pohutu geyser, which erupts up to 20 times a day.

Carving and Weaving Schools - Te Puia is home to the New Zealand National Carving and Weaving Schools. Te Wānanga Whakairo Rākau is where the prestigious art of carving is taught by Master Carvers. Te Rito, our weaving school, trains students in the art and skills of weaving. Watch the carvers and weavers as they carry out the traditions of their Māori ancestors.

Taonga Gallery and Gift Shop - Take home something unique and special from Te Puia. See a wide range of wood carvings, greenstone (New Zealand jade) carvings, woven items and other authentic Māori treasures (taonga).

Cultural performances include:

Pōwhiri (ceremonial welcome) - This is a ceremony of encounter between two parties who meet for the first time. Host warriors challenge the visiting party to find out their intentions. If these are friendly, the visitors are invited into the ancestral meeting house.

Hongi (ceremonial greeting) - The gentle pressing of noses symbolizing the joining of two life forces creating an atmosphere of friendship and unity.

Kapa haka (cultural performance) - This performance celebrates the very best of Māori performing arts. It includes weaponry displays, action songs, the famed haka (challenge) and the graceful poi.

Titi torea (stick game) - This was a favourite pastime of old and young alike. Performers pass batons to and fro in time to the rhythm of the song, testing their skills of agility and hand-eye co-ordination.

Haka (challenge) - Before battle the warrior would summon all his strength to perform this challenge. Aggressive actions, such as bulging out the eyes, thrusting out the tongue and making guttural sounds, would serve to intimidate any enemy.

Waiata-a-ringā (action song) - Hand and body actions accompany songs, portraying traditional stories and legends in dance.

KNOW-B-4-U-GO

Requirements: Every traveler must have a valid Passport with at least 6 free pages and must not expire for a period of 6 months after trip return date. A Visa is required for Australia and New Zealand. **Cost for Australia Visa is US \$13-\$15 per person. Cost for New Zealand Visa is US \$75.** You will process them electronically online. Application process will be shared with you.

US Domestic air to/from Los Angeles, CA., is arranged by you. Our international flight departs from Los Angeles, CA. (LAX) International flight to Cairns Australia, by way of Auckland NZ. We will provide the full International Air Schedules later. *Please note that there will be a minimum of eight (8) flights, depending on the group size.*

Payment Terms: To secure your space a deposit of **\$1000** is due at booking with a copy of your PASSPORT. A second deposit of **\$2000** is due **August 26, 2026. If registering at the second deposit due date, you will register with a full \$2600 deposit. Final payment is due January 08, 2027!** Failure to meet the terms of this tour package will result in automatic late fee penalties not less than \$50 plus any additional penalties charged at the discretion of the travel industry suppliers. Refunds will not be issued after penalty dates. *Please alert our agency if you are applying or renewing your Passport.* **Monthly payments are welcomed! (\$1,125 per month, db. occupancy starting June 2026 through January 2027) Total of 8 months**

Cancellation: Initial **\$600** deposit is nonrefundable/nontransferable. A full deposit **(\$2500)** penalty begins **September 08, 2026**, and under full penalty **February 08, 2027.**

When completing the registration form, please ensure your name matches your passport exactly to avoid penalty fees. Provide your full name, date of birth, passport number, and emergency contact information; otherwise, your registration will not be processed.

Gratuity: Suggested amount to tip, \$15 per person per day. Tips will be collected upon check-in at the first hotel in Australia (\$180 per person). Gratuities cover our tour guide, drivers and luggage handlers. It does not cover hotel housekeeping.

Spending money: Although we cannot tell you how much money to travel with, outside of your necessities and meals not included. It is safe to say \$50 per day should be more than enough if you are on a budget. Casual dining out in both Australia & New Zealand US\$15-\$25

Baggage: Each person is allowed 1 checked bag, weighing 50lbs or less and 1 carry-on 15-18lbs, plus a purse or backpack. All bags will be weighed! For short hop flights, luggage limit may be 44lbs. Pack light and smart. Weather in both locations, vary 50 – 80 degrees

Electric Outlets: The system operates at **230-240V** and **50Hz**. **You also need a voltage converter.**
