Breakfast at hotel, Full day Modern Dubai City with Burj Khalifa visit “At the Top”



This tour will be conducted by Coach Bus with professional English speaking guide

Depart from Hotel drive towards the **Burj Al Arab** (outside visit only), the luxury hotel built on a manmade island, where you will pause for photographs.

Drive to the new marina for more photo opportunities - **Dubai Marina** – the world’s largest master planned waterfront development of its kind. Next we drive around Emirates Hills, offering the ultimate lifestyle experience.

Our next stop is **The Palm Jumeirah**- 8th wonder of the world, an artificial island in the shape of a palm tree. Driving across its trunk, we take a closer look at its themed boutique hotels, signature villas, apartment buildings. Photo-stop at **Atlantis the Palm**

We then continue **Souk Al Bahar** (market of the sailor), an Arabesque shopping mall and entertainment destination located in the heart of the prestigious Downtown Burj Khalifa, on the Old Town Island. The cultural theme flows throughout, with boutique shops showcasing the Arabian heritage through a mix of authentic handicrafts, fashion wear, perfumes, carpets and furnishings.

VISIT DUBAI MALL – AT THE TOP -BURJ KHALIFA

The Dubai Mall is one of the largest shopping malls in the world. It covers a total area of 12.1 million square feet, with 10 - 15 individual smaller malls built inside it, consisting of 9 million square feet of shopping retail space (comprising of a total of 1200 stores). Featured attractions include the world's largest gold souk with 220 retailers; the 850,000 square feet Fashion Island, with 70 flagship stores dedicated to haute couture as well as the Middle East's first Galleries Lafayette department store; one of the world's largest aquariums; an Olympic-sized ice-skating rink; Oasis Fountain Waterfall; Waterfront Atrium; a view of the world's tallest building, Burj Khalifa.

Visit Burj Khalifa, the tallest tower in the world. – Level 124 – Observation Deck

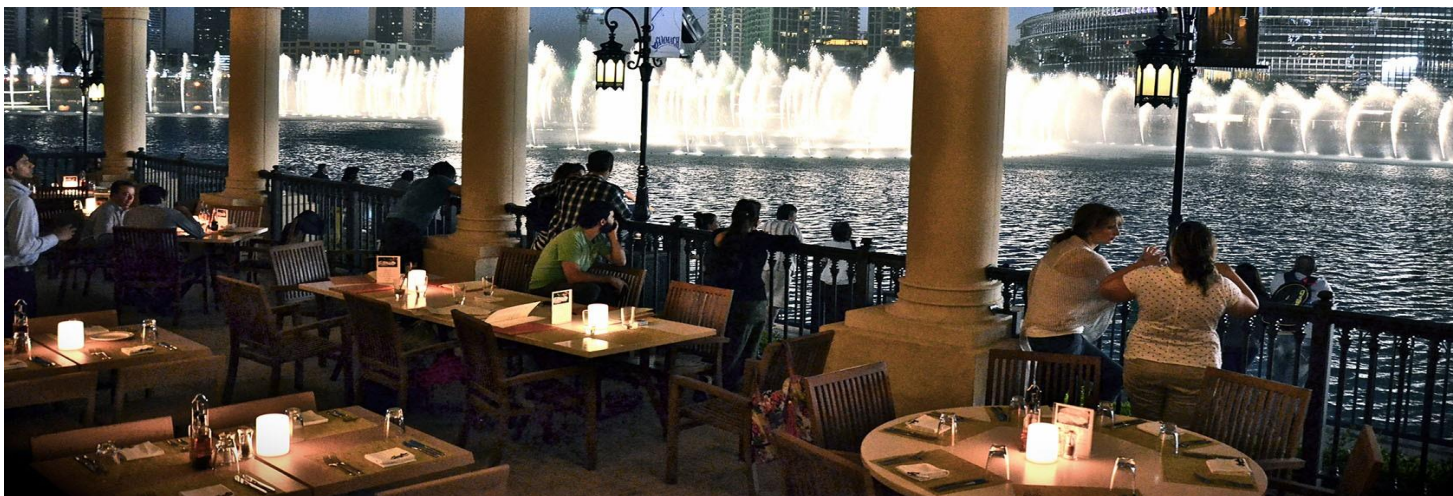

Breakfast at hotel - Full Day Abu Dhabi City Tour





This tour will be conducted by Coach Bus with professional English speaking guide and the duration of the tour is about 08 hours. Abu Dhabi, the capital city of the United Arab Emirates, is situated on a small peninsula surrounded by a cluster of islands. The city was founded in 1761 by a Sheikh of the Bani Yas tribe. This tour offers an ideal introduction to the heritage and culture of Abu Dhabi city.

Visit **Sheikh Zayed Mosque** in Abu Dhabi is the largest mosque in the United Arab Emirates and the eighth largest mosque in the world. The Mosque is large enough to accommodate 40,000 worshippers. The main prayer hall can accommodate up to 9,000 worshippers.

Entrance to Grand Mosque is closed on Friday Morning and can be visited after 4.30pm

Slip-on shoes are recommended for this tour. Respectful attire is recommended when going ashore in a Muslim country. Women visiting the mosque must cover their entire body with including their head with a scarf, leaving their hands and face exposed. Food, drinks and smoking are strictly prohibited at the mosque. Guests not following the dress code will not be allowed to enter the mosque. The mosque will not be providing the abayas.

After your mosque visit group continue to see the **Heritage Village** which houses a small museum and depicts the daily activities of the Arab community prior to the discovery of oil. Drive past the beautiful **Abu Dhabi Corniche** and interesting sights around the city of Abu Dhabi. Group will pass by **Emirates Palace** for a brief photo stop from outside.

Lunch at a local restaurant with soft beverage

Drive around **Yas Island** and a photo stop at **Ferrari World**

Visit Louvre Museum

Classic Dubai City Tour – Half day



This tour will be conducted by Coach Bus with professional English speaking guide and the duration of the tour is about 04 hours driving along “the beach road” we’ll stop for photo at the **Jumeirah Mosque** – a magnificent example of Islamic architecture, we then continue to the **Al Fahidi Historical District (Bastakia area)** – the oldest part of the city, where we’ll see the Wind Towers which served as air-conditioners in bygone days.

We then enjoy a ride across the famed **Dubai creek** in a local water taxi which is called “**Abra**” to see the bustling activities on the waterfront and move on to the Deira side of Dubai. You can truly admire the spectacle of old and new Dubai from the traditional houses, towers and minarets that you pass by on an abra.

This will be followed by a visit to the aromatic **Spice souq** and the vast glittering **Gold souq** where you can buy exquisite gold jewelry at prices lower than in Europe.

Dhow Cruise Dinner at Dubai Marina (02 Hours) *Non-exclusive dhow

Guests will be transferred to the quay at Dubai Marina to board the traditional wooden boat (Dhow) for a 2 hour sharing dinner cruise giving guests the opportunity to view and experience Dubai during the night time.

Slipping softly and silently along the **Dubai Creek** on a traditional wooden vessel, invites you to delight in charmingly different perspectives of this city of contrasts. Modern and traditional views display the rather fast pace from a time-honored centre of trade to a focal point of commerce over just a few decades. Explore the breath-taking Dubai skyline as you sail past the Marina for an unforgettable experience, especially when paired with a gourmet 5-star dinner and delightful atmospheric music to set the tone. Experience the authentic delight of this majestic city, all from the deck of a traditional wooden dhow. The ideal way to celebrate Dubai's rich heritage . Half Day Sharjah City Tour - [OPTIONAL]



This tour will be conducted by Coach Bus with professional English speaking guide and the duration of the tour is about 04.5 hours

Sharjah, the third largest Emirate of UAE has been crowned as the Cultural Capital of the Arab World by UNESCO for its dedication in preserving the art, culture, heritage and history. It is the only Emirate to have land on both the Arabian Gulf Coast and the Gulf of Oman.

*Begin your Sharjah sightseeing with a photo stop at the **Cultural Square** or the **Quran Roundabout**. Here you will find a sculpture with verses carved out from Holy Quran. Then, you will visit the **Sharjah Museum of Islamic Civilization**, which is home to exquisite Islamic artefacts from around the world. The building which houses the museum was once Al Majarrah Souk. The building now houses more than 5,000 exquisite artifacts from all over the Islamic World. Next stop is the **Sharjah Calligraphy museum** which is a fascinating journey of discovery across centuries of Arabian heritage in the form of beautifully written script created by local artists and well-known international calligraphers, significant works of art from the Arab world demonstrate the complexity of this vibrant art form and its historical and Islamic foundations.*



Next visit to Heritage Area which houses a traditional souq, an ancient school and a few small museums. Last but not the least is the fabulous Central Souk also known as **Blue Souq**. Boasting typical Arabic architecture and hundreds of shops – dealing in Leather, Fabrics, antiques etc. ** Sharjah Islamic Museum is closed on Friday Morning and can be visited after 3pm*

Desert Safari with BBQ Dinner at a Bedouin Campsite



Guests depart to the Desert of Arabia for an excursion that will probably be one of the highlights of their visit to Dubai. Proceed with 4WD vehicles with **6 guests with an English speaking driver per car**.

During this excursion the guests will have the opportunity to explore the vast, silent ocean of golden-hued sand dunes with experienced drivers giving guests the opportunity to enjoy some exciting “**Dune Bashing**”. Dune bashing literally means bashing the dunes with the thrill of going up and down, provoking shrieks of laughter and tons of excitement. After a challenging ride across the desert and reaching our traditional Arabic camp, guests will have the opportunity to ride camels.

Buffet Dinner with soft beverages & Belly Dance performance will be at the Campsite, clients can also enjoy bubbly & a Henna lady will be present in case any ladies want to get hand painting the traditional Arabic way.

This will be followed by a photo stop at the residence of his **Majesty Sultan Qaboos, the Al Alam Palace**, which is flanked by the 16th century Portuguese forts Mirani and Jalali. Before ending the tour, you will be strolling through **Muttrah Souq**, where you can bargain for Omani handicrafts and silver items.
