ARRIVING AT NYC AIRPORTS

Taxi Regulations to NYC Airports

Newark International Airport - The set fare between New York City to Newark International Airport is the regular metered rate of fare, plus a \$17.50 surcharge, plus all tolls going to and returning from the airport.

John F. Kennedy International Airport - There is a "Flat Fare" program for trips to and from JFK and Manhattan. The flat fare is \$52.00 plus any tolls. The meter will not be turned on, and the night surcharge will not be added. A \$4.50 rush hour surcharge applies to all JFK flat fares on weekdays between the hours of 4 PM and 8 PM. If passengers request multiple stops, the flat rate of \$52 will be collected at the first stop in Manhattan, and the meter will be turned on for the remainder of the trip. The metered fare should be collected at the last stop, from the last passenger. There is no set fare to or from JFK to any point in New York City outside of Manhattan, and the metered rate applies.

LaGuardia International Airport - There is no set fare for trips to and from LaGuardia International Airport. The regular metered rate of fare, as is displayed below, applies in all cases.

Airports: Shuttles, Express Buses, and Rail

SuperShuttle (blue and yellow van). Operates direct service daily, 24 hours. Return trip requires 24 hours notice. Telephone 1.212.209.7000, toll free 1.800.BLUE.VAN.

NYC Airporter Express Shuttle Bus. NYC Airporter also provides New York Airport Transfers between JFK & LGA airports, every 20-30 minutes. Express buses depart from Grand Central, Penn Station and the Port Authority Bus Terminal in Manhattan.

Gray Line Air Shuttle Minibus. Serves a number of hotels directly from JFK, LaGuardia, and Newark airports. Pre-book online at <https://graylinenewyork.com/new-york-tours/airport-transfer/>

Newark Airport Express Bus Express. bus service between Newark Liberty Airport and New York City Port Authority. Buses run every 15 minutes during the day, 365 days a year (departures every 30 minutes before 6:45 AM and after 11:15 PM).

AirTrain. The regional rail transportation connection between Newark or JFK Airports and New York Penn Station. Passengers can take scheduled NJ Transit or Amtrak rail service between New York Penn Station. GETTING AROUND NYC

Public Transportation

New York City Transit (Subway and Bus) - Fares on the New York City transit system (MTA) are currently \$2.75 per trip (includes one free transfer—bus to bus, or bus to train, or train to bus). You can also purchase a multiple-ride or unlimited-ride MetroCard and receive discounted fares. Buses accept MetroCards or exact change only.

- From New York Penn Station, take the #1 subway line (Direction Van Cortlandt Park – 242 St) to 50 St Broadway station and walk half a block to Crowne Plaza. Alternatively, its about a 17 minute walk along 7th Ave to Broadway.
- From Grand Central Station, take the the #7 subway line (Direction 34th St - 11 Av) to Times Sq – 42 St station and walk down 7th Ave to Broadway. To walk from Grand Central, exit onto East 45 St, turn left (West) 0.6 miles to Broadway, turn right to the Crowne Plaza at 1605 Broadway (46th St). Total about 15 mins walk.

OTHER SERVICES TO MANHATTAN

Long Island Railroad - For travel from Long Island, arriving in New York Penn Station

Metro-North Railroad - For travel from points north, arriving in Grand Central Station

New Jersey Transit - From New Jersey, arriving in New York Penn Station.

Staten Island Ferry - Service from Staten Island, connecting to Manhattan MTA buses and subways.

Amtrak - For travel from points throughout the United States and Canada, arriving in New York Penn Station, and Newark Penn Station.
