

Getting to Strasbourg

By plane

International airport

Paris Charles de Gaulle (<https://www.parisaeroport.fr/en/passengers/charles-de-gaulle-airport>) – High-speed train to Strasbourg (direct or via Paris). Tips: put Strasbourg as final destination when you book the ticket

Basel EuroAirport (<https://www.euroairport.com/en>) – Bus shuffle to Saint Louis train station (<https://www.euroairport.com/en/transport>) – Train to Strasbourg (<https://www.sncf-connect.com/en-en>)

Frankfurt airport (<https://www.frankfurt-airport.com/en.html>) – direct bus shuffle from the airport to the Strasbourg train station. Tips: put Strasbourg as final destination when you book the ticket.

By train

Strasbourg train station is located at walking distance from the city center and connected to the Tram.

By car
