AN ACT concerning

Notarial Acts – Protest Form Requirement – Repeal

FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that a notary public use a certain protest form; and generally relating to protest forms for notarial acts.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Government

[18–106.

It is unlawful for any notary public to sign and issue any protest except in the form prescribed by the Comptroller.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
