- d. all important decisions shall be reached by discussion, vote and, whenever possible, by substantial unanimity
 (Dialogue);
- e. no service action shall ever be personally punitive or a incitement to public controversy (Compassion); and
- f. no OA service committee or service board shall ever perform acts of government, and each shall always remain democratic in thought and action (Respect).

- Develop fun fellowship activities & workshops
- Encourage meetings to have OA approved pamphlets and books on the topic of relapse and recovery available to members
- Maintain a relapse survivor speaker contact list
- Have a committee member active in the Region and World Service Business Conference levels 12th step within committees
- Have a means to connect those willing to sponsor and those in need of a sponsor (available sponsors raise hand in meeting formats, host sponsorship workshops, sponsor/sponsee speed dating)
- Observe OA sponsorship day the 3rd weekend in August
- Have a relapse and recovery special focus meeting in your intergroup/service body
- Have an organized means of encouraging members to reach out to newcomers, returners, those who may be struggling and those not regularly attending meetings.

The Promises Workshop

First of all, to Wendy, the three groups, and all the speakers: Thank you so much for a wonderful workshop!! Coming back into program after being gone for a couple of years, The Promises Workshop was the best place for me to start.

- Step 4 is doing a personal inventory of all my grudges towards people, institutions and principles. It makes me look at my inner self. <u>All</u> my resentments. "Resentment is the number one offender." p. 64
- Step 5 promises "Now we begin to have a spiritual experience" p. 76. I refer to Spiritual Experience p. 567 to remember that it is as psychologist William James calls, "the educational variety because they develop slowly over a period of time."
- Step 8 "<u>Willing</u> to make amends." It is written in the step and on p. 77. This helps me to continue my path of a spiritual experience because I became <u>WILLING!!</u>
- Step 9 promises remind me all that I will receive If I have done ALL the steps 1 through 8.
- Step 10 promises tell me since I have "cleared up the past," doing step 10 everyday will help me to continue to receive the promises.
- Step 11 suggests to me if I follow the suggestions on ps. 84-88 I will continue to walk on the spiritual path to a healthy mind and heart. "That is how we react so long as we keep in <u>fit spiritual condition."</u> p. 85. For me that is what helps me to change my eating behaviors.

We have to remember it is not about the food and all the food behaviors that go along with our disease. It's about The Big Book and all the promises. If I follow the suggestions I will walk on my spiritual path and I will live all the promises the Big Book offers. "Spiritual life is not a theory. We have to live it." p.83.
